### Travel Advisory: State Road 200 Lane Closure Schedule

**Yulee, Fla.** – This advisory is to inform community leaders and interested parties about upcoming scheduled lane closures, traffic shifts and other construction activity on State Road 200/A1A. For a complete list of scheduled lane closures in northeast Florida, interested parties may visit [www.NFLRoads.com/TrafficReport](http://www.NFLRoads.com/TrafficReport).

Drivers can also set up real-time traffic alerts from FL511, a free service offered by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). Motorists can visit [www.FL511.com](http://www.FL511.com) or call #511 for this up-to-date information.

The Florida Department of Transportation has permitted multiple lane closures as part of the State Road 200/A1A improvement projects. Below are several lane closures planned for August 7 through August 14, weather permitting. Certain activities may require unexpected lane closures for the safety of both drivers and construction workers.

**Notable:** FDOT crews will conduct a traffic shift on westbound State Road 200 just east of I-95 during the overnight hours of Thursday, August 13. The traffic shift marks an important milestone for construction of the Diverging Diamond Interchange. Drivers are encouraged to plan ahead for the traffic shift and use caution when driving the new traffic pattern.

#### **Daytime lane closures:**

**Interstate 95:** None at this time.

**State Road 200:** None at this time.

#### **Chester Road:**

- The southbound left or right lane of Chester Road at State Road 200 is expected to be closed Saturday, August 8 from 7 a.m. to noon. These are alternating closures with only one lane closed at time.

### Nighttime lane closures:

#### **Interstate 95:**

- The right and center lane of I-95 southbound from north of the State Road 200 to just south of the State Road 200 exit are expected to be closed Tuesday, August 11 from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. This closure will not impact the exit ramp to State Road 200.

#### **State Road 200:**

- The eastbound right lane of State Road 200 from St. Peters Boulevard to Meadowfield Bluffs Road is expected to be closed Saturday, August 8 from 12 a.m. to noon.
- The westbound left lane of State Road 200 from St. Peters Boulevard to Meadowfield Bluffs Road is expected to be closed Saturday, August 8 from 12 a.m. to noon.
- The westbound left lane of State Road 200 from Peoples Road to the west end of the project is expected to be closed Monday, August 8 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- The westbound left lane of State Road 200 from Gene Lasserre Boulevard to the Lofton Creek Boat Ramp is expected to be closed Tuesday, August 11 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- The westbound left lane of State Road 200 from Blackrock Road to Nassau Place is expected to be closed Wednesday, August 12 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- The westbound left lane of State Road 200 from Barnwell Road to Blackrock Road is expected to be closed Thursday, August 12 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- The westbound left lane of State Road 200 from just west of the I-95 overpass to Still Quarters Road are expected to be closed Thursday, August 13 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- The westbound left lane of State Road 200 from just west of the I-95 overpass to Still Quarters Road are expected to be closed Friday, August 14 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- The westbound left lane Barnwell Road to O'Neil Scott Road is expected to be closed Friday, August 14 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- The eastbound right lane of State Road 200 at Old Nassauville Road is expected to be closed August 14 from 11 p.m. to noon.
