Travel Advisory: State Road 200 Lane Closure Schedule

Yulee, Fla. – This advisory is to inform community leaders and interested parties about upcoming, scheduled lane closures, traffic shifts and other construction activity on State Road 200/A1A. For a complete list of scheduled lane closures in northeast Florida, interested parties may visit: www.NFLRoads.com/TrafficReport.

Drivers can also setup real-time traffic alerts from FL511, a free service offered by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). Motorists can visit www.FL511.com or call #511 for this up-to-date information.

The Florida Department of Transportation has permitted multiple lane closures as part of the State Road 200/A1A (S.R. 200) improvement projects. Below are several planned lane closures, weather permitting, planned for October 11 through October 17. Certain activities may require unexpected lane closures for the safety of both drivers and construction workers.

Notable: While not associated with the FDOT's State Road 200 project, Gene Lasserre Boulevard at State Road 200 will be closed to traffic beginning Monday, October 21 at 10 p.m. until work is complete, but no later than 5 a.m. for milling and resurfacing work. Drivers are encouraged to plan ahead.

Daytime lane closures:

Interstate 95: Lane closures are not expected at this time.

State Road 200:

- One eastbound lane of State Road 200 from west of I-95 to Mentoria Road is expected to be closed Saturday, October 12 from 7 a.m. until 5:30 p.m.
- One westbound lane of State Road 200 from west of I-95 to Mentoria Road is expected to be closed Saturday, October 12 from 7 a.m. until 5:30 p.m.
- The westbound right lane of State Road 200 from Meadowfields Bluffs Road to Harry Green Road is expected to be closed Saturday, October 12 from 7 a.m. until 6 p.m.

Nighttime lane closures:

State Road 200:

- The westbound right lane of State Road 200 from Eric Oliver Way to Meadowfield Bluffs Road is expected to be closed Wednesday, October 16 from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. Thursday, October 17.
- The westbound right lane of State Road 200 from David Hallman Parkway to Eric Oliver Way is expected to be closed Thursday, October 17 from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. Friday, October 18.

Barnwell Road:

- The northbound or southbound right lane of Barnwell Road at State Road 200 is expected to be closed Sunday, October 13 from 6 p.m. until 6 a.m. Monday, October 14. This closure will alternate with only one lane closed at a time.
- The northbound or southbound right lane of Barnwell Road at State Road 200 is expected to be closed Monday, October 14 from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. Friday, October 18. This closure will alternate with only one lane closed at a time.

Gene Lasserre Boulevard:

- The northbound or southbound right lane of Gene Lasserre Boulevard at State Road 200 is expected to be closed Wednesday, October 16 from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. Thursday, October 17. This closure will alternate with only one lane closed at a time.

Chester Road:

- The northbound or southbound right lane of Chester Road at State Road 200 is expected to be closed Thursday, October 17 from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. Friday, October 18. This closure will alternate with only one lane closed at a time.

Nassau County Advisory: While unrelated to the S.R. 200 corridor, interested parties may appreciate the following information:

The Florida Department of Transportation has temporarily closed a portion of County Road 121/Baldwin and Saint George Road between Turkey Trot Trail and Carroll Corner Road.

The closure will be in place until rehabilitation work is completed on a bridge culvert damaged from erosion. Northbound and southbound drivers on County Road 121 will detour to U.S. 301 via County Road 108 and Henry Smith Road.
