### Travel Advisory: State Road 200 Lane Closure Schedule

**Yulee, Fla.** – This advisory is to inform community leaders and interested parties about upcoming, scheduled lane closures, traffic shifts and other construction activity on State Road 200/A1A. The Florida Department of Transportation has permitted multiple lane closures as part of the State Road 200/A1A (S.R. 200) improvement projects. Below are several planned lane closures, weather permitting, planned for January 3 through January 10. Certain activities may require unexpected lane closures for the safety of both drivers and construction workers.

**Notable:** Crews will be conducting a traffic shift beginning Friday, January 10 on State Road 200 between Meadowfield Bluffs Road and Peoples Road. During the shift, a single westbound lane will be closed, weather permitting. Drivers are encouraged to plan accordingly.

#### **Daytime lane closures:**

**Interstate 95:** None at this time.

**State Road 200:** None at this time

#### **Nighttime lane closures:**

##### **State Road 200:**

- The westbound lanes of State Road 200 from Meadowfield Bluffs Road to Peoples Road are expected to be shifted Friday, January 10 from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. The shift will require lane closures and drivers are encouraged to plan accordingly.

Throughout construction, drivers are encouraged to plan ahead, use caution and follow traffic laws. Construction is a temporary inconvenience toward a more permanent transportation solution.
