### **Travel Advisory: Acosta Bridge Southbound Ramp at Broad Street closed Monday and Tuesday**

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The southbound ramp to the Acosta Bridge (State Road 13) at Broad Street will be closed Monday, February 1 and Tuesday, February 2 from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. for routine bridge maintenance.

Traffic will detour west from Broad Street via Riverside Avenue to I-95 southbound.
