U.S. 301 and I-10 Interchange Detour and Ramp Opening on Night of January 12

BALDWIN, Fla. – As part of the I-10 and U.S. 301 interchange improvement project, the new ramp for eastbound I-10 traffic exiting onto U.S. 301 will open by 5 a.m. Jan. 13. To prepare for the opening of the new ramp, I-10 eastbound to U.S. 301 will close and traffic detoured the night of Jan. 12 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Eastbound I-10 to U.S. 301 detour: Traffic will continue traveling on eastbound I-10 to the the northbound State Road 23 exit, take the ramp to I-10 westbound and proceed to the U.S. 301 exit.

Superior Construction Company began the \$65 million interchange improvement project in February 2016 and is estimated to complete the work early 2024, weather and schedule permitting.
