WATCH: Emergency repair work on I-95 Completed in 25 Days

Jacksonville, Fla. – Construction crews completed emergency bridge repairs on I-95 over Crestwood Street 20 days ahead of schedule. The project included repairing and replacing portions of the structure’s beams and deck. The structure was damaged by a truck with an over-height load striking the overpass while driving on Crestwood Street.

FDOT District 2 Secretary Greg Evans said, “I-95 is the gateway to Florida for much of the East Coast and serves as an evacuation route when hurricanes threaten. When this incident occurred, our bridge teams responding quickly to inspect the damage and developed a plan to open I-95 as quickly and safely as possible. I’m proud of our teams and the rapid response they demonstrated for this project.”

During construction, the southbound outside lane of I-95 was closed while crews installed the new deck. The contractor, Superior Construction, was awarded a \$150,000 incentive bonus for completing the project ahead of schedule.
