Weekend Detour Planned for Prudential Drive at State Road 5 Bridge

JACKSONVILLE, Fla.- As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s improvement project on the State Road 5/Main Street bridge over Prudential Drive, the State Road 5 Bridge will be closed to traffic Friday, March 12, at 7 p.m. through Monday, March 15 at 6:30 a.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The closure is necessary to complete bridge deck work on the overpass.

Northbound and southbound traffic will detour via Main Street.

To safely complete work on and under the bridge, overnight lane closures and detours are expected for the duration of the project. Pedestrians are encouraged to follow the guided pedestrian detour signs while in place.

Extreme Sandblasting and Painting, Inc. is estimated to complete the \$1.6 million bridge improvement project in late summer 2021. Construction completion estimates are fluid and subject to change, weather and schedule permitting.
