

Westbound Beach Boulevard and Hart Expressway from Parental Home Road to Dean Road Closed Wednesday and Thursday Nights

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Westbound lanes of Beach Boulevard and the Hart Expressway from Parental Home Road to Dean Road will be closed overnight Wednesday, October 28 and Thursday, October 29 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. The closures are needed to allow for work related to the construction of a median wall near the Hart Expressway/Beach Boulevard westbound ramp. To avoid delays, drivers should seek alternate routes during these hours.

Westbound Beach Boulevard and Hart Expressway traffic will detour to Parental Home Road and Dean Road. Hart Expressway traffic will continue to University Boulevard and the Hart Expressway interchange.
