Work to Begin on Improvements to I-295 and 103rd Street Interchange

Jacksonville – Construction is expected to begin January 3 on improvements to 103rd Street (State Road 134) at I-295, which will include the entrance and exit ramps of the interchange and the roadway under the I-295 overpass up to Firestone Road at Westside High School.

Project safety improvements include construction of a dual eastbound left turn lane to I-295 north, construction of a dual westbound left turn lane at Firestone Road, widening of the 103rd Street roadway at the I-295 interchange and Firestone Road intersection, installation of pedestrian signals with countdown timers, sidewalk replacement and guardrail installation.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project. No lane closures will be permitted between 6 a.m. and 10 p.m. seven days a week during construction. Lane closure notices will be available at www.nflroads.com.

Capps Land Management, LLC is expected to complete the \$3.3 million improvement project by late summer 2018.
