FDOT to Detour Ramps Nightly Next Week as part of I-295 Interchange Project

Jacksonville, Fla. – Next week, FDOT will temporarily detour multiple exit ramps and part of U.S. 17 beginning Monday, March 16 through Thursday, March 19 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. as part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvement project.

I-295 westbound to I-95 northbound: Drivers will be detoured to U.S. 17 and Airport Center Drive, where they can access I-95 northbound.

I-295 eastbound to I-95 northbound: Drivers will be detoured to U.S. 17 and Airport Center Drive, where they can access I-95 northbound.

I-295 westbound to U.S. 17: Drivers will be detoured to I-295 eastbound and Pulaski Road.

I-95 southbound to I-295 eastbound: Drivers will be detoured to Airport Center drive and U.S. 17, where they can access I-295 eastbound.

U.S. 17 to I-295 westbound: Drivers will be detoured to I-295 eastbound to Pulaski Road, where they can access I-295 westbound.

This work is part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvement project that includes a new collector-distributor system, auxiliary lanes and ramp improvements. The interchange is part of an important corridor to promote economic growth and development in the region.

FDOT selected Archer Western to complete this \$176.8 million project in summer 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
