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# **Time Lapse of Recent Beam Placements**




#### **OCTOBER 11, 2022**

Westbound Call Street (SR 230) Detour: Westbound Call Street will be closed with local traffic access only from Cherry Street to U.S. 301. Vehicles travelling westbound will turn right onto Cherry Street, turn left onto Jackson Street, left onto Walnut Street, right onto Jefferson Street, turn left onto U.S. 301 and proceed to Call Street.

**Southbound Thompson Street Detour:** Vehicles travelling southbound on Thompson Street toward SR 230 will turn right onto Jefferson Street, turn left onto U.S. 301, turn left onto SR 100, do a U-turn at Thompson Street, turn right on Walnut Street and proceed to Thompson Street.

**Southbound Walnut Street Detour:** Vehicles seeking to travel southbound on Walnut Street toward Call Street will turn right onto Jefferson Street, turn left onto U.S. 301, turn left onto SR 100, make a U-turn at Thompson Street and proceed to Walnut Street.



# **Upcoming Work and Detours - Westbound Call Street (SR 230)**




#### **OCTOBER 11, 2022**

**Eastbound Call Street (SR 230) Detour:** Eastbound Call Street will be closed with local traffic access only from U.S. 301 to Cherry Street. Vehicles seeking to travel eastbound will travel north on U.S. 301, turn right on Jefferson Street, left onto Thompson Street, right onto Jackson Street, turn right onto Cherry Street and proceed to Call Street.

**Northbound Thompson Street Detour:** Vehicles travelling northbound on Thompson Street toward SR 100 will turn left onto SR 100, turn right onto U.S. 301, turn right onto Jefferson Street and proceed to Thompson Street.

**Southbound Thompson Street Detour:** Vehicles originating north of Call Street and travelling south on Thompson Street will turn right onto Call Street, turn left on U.S. 301, turn left onto SR 100 and proceed to Thompson Street.

**Northbound Walnut Street Detour:** Vehicles seeking to travel northbound on Walnut Street from SR 100 will be detoured to U.S. 301, will turn right onto U.S. 301, right onto Jefferson Street and proceed to Walnut Street.
