Project Information

Project description: The scope of work includes all investigation, design, permitting, coordination, final approved construction documents, and construction activities necessary for the construction of the First Coast Expressway (SR 23) from east of the CR 16A Spur to east of CR 209 and additional improvements.

Construction Start: May 2023

Estimated Completion: 2030

Cost: \$595 million

Contractor: Johnson Bros./American Bridge









Project Improvements

- Length: 6.5 miles, including a 9,300-foot bridge
- Increased speed limit of 70 mph
- 65-foot vertical clearance
- Two 12-foot wide travel lanes in each direction
- 12-foot wide outside shoulders
- 12-foot, 8.5-inch wide shared use path on the northbound side of the bridge to accommodate pedestrians and bicyclists





Project Improvements

- Once the new bridge is completed, FDOT will demolish most of the existing Shands bridge, leaving a portion of the bridge on both the Clay and St. Johns sides of the river for recreational purposes
- FDOT investments in these new recreational facilities include barrier walls, parking, lighting, ADA accommodations and sidewalks





Lane Closure Restrictions

- No lane closures allowed from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. and no detours allowed from 5 a.m. to 11 p.m. on SR 23, SR 16, SR 13, CR 16A, CR 210, Longleaf Pine Parkway
- No lane closures or detours allowed on existing Shands Bridge
- No lane closures allowed from 6 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. on Leonard C. Taylor Parkway
