



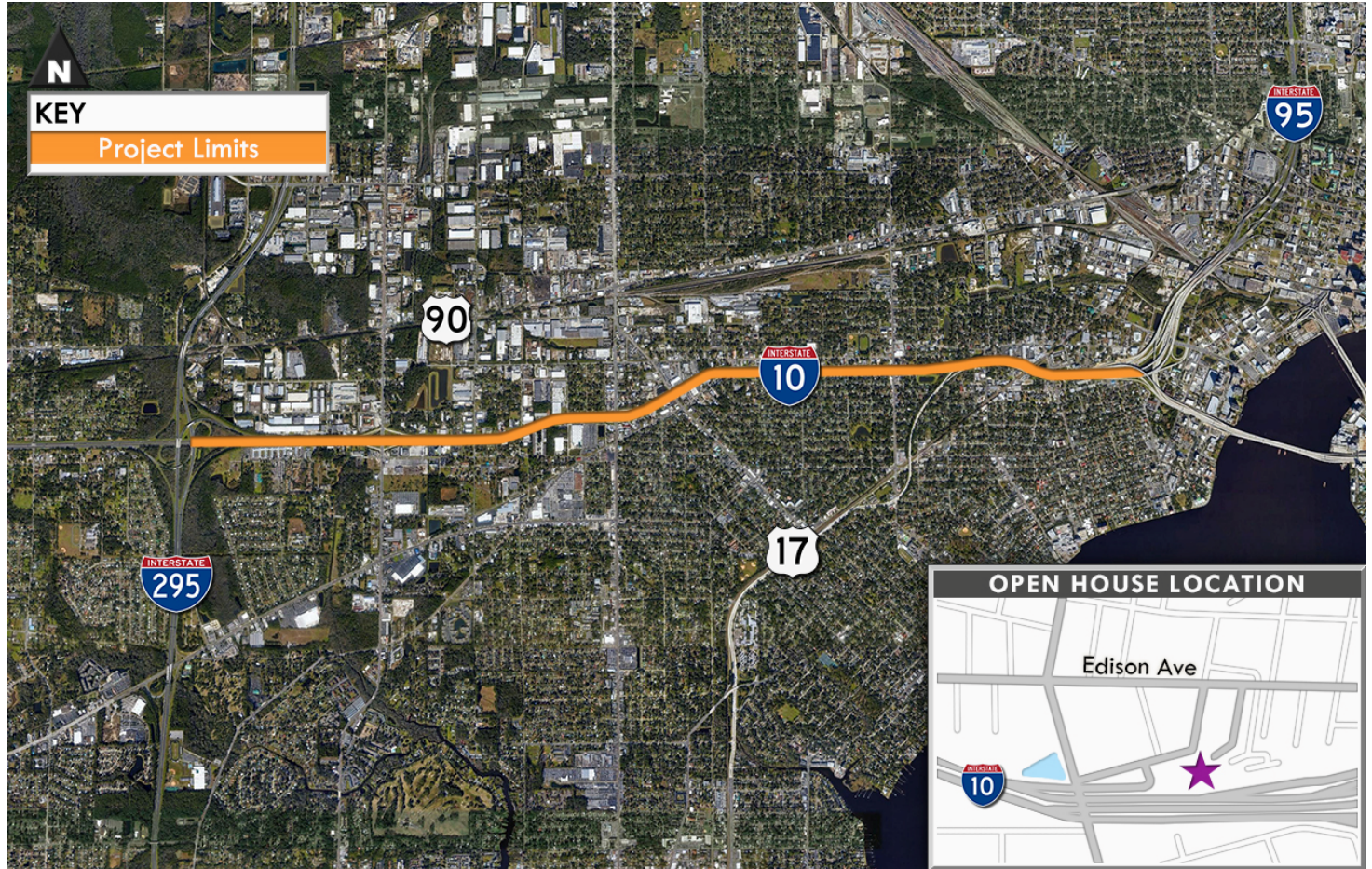

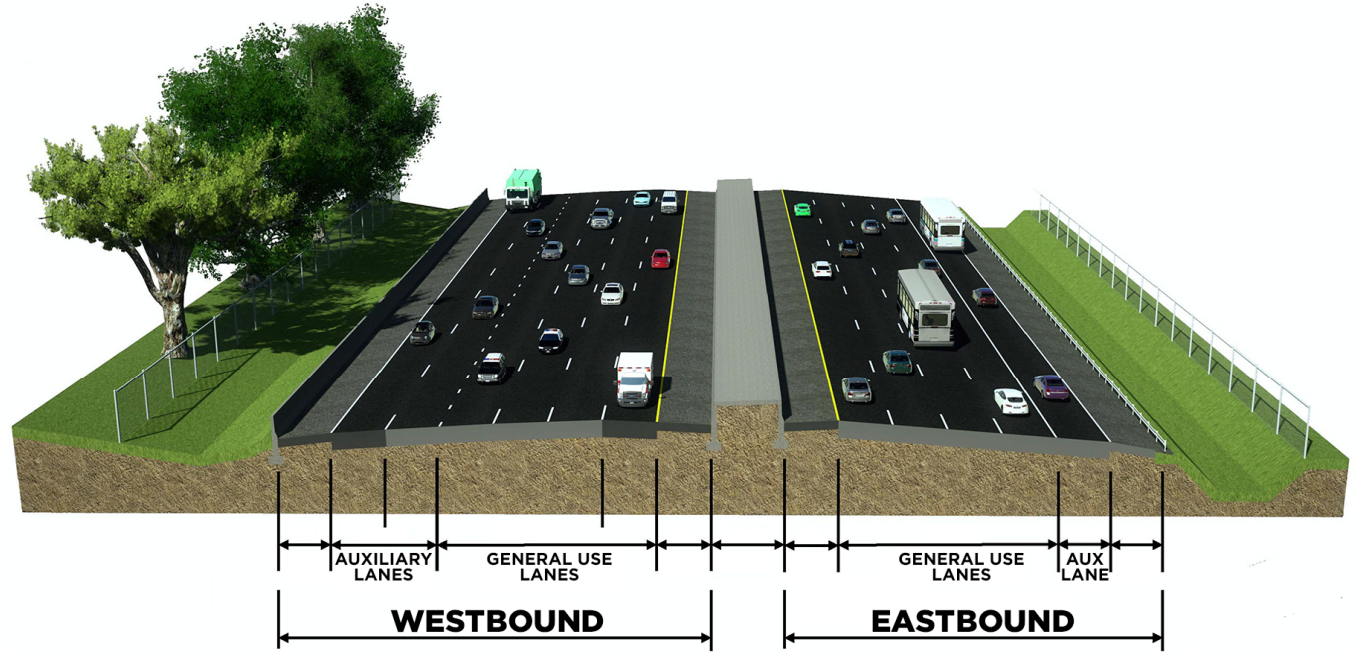

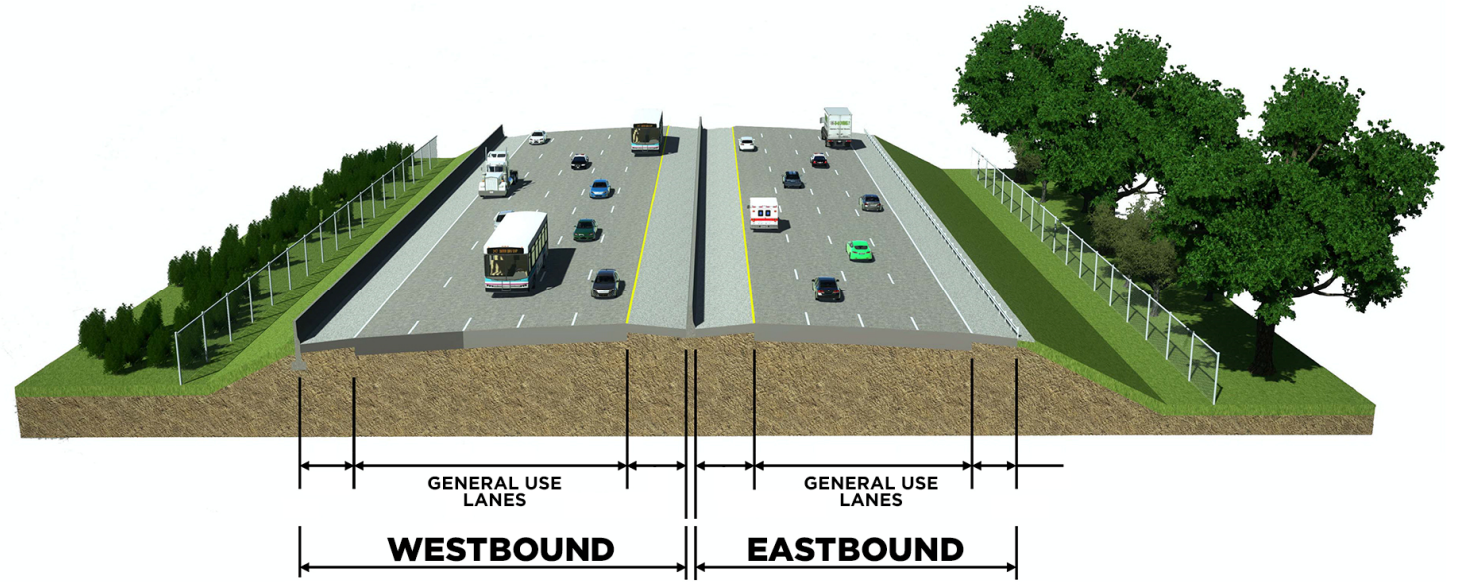
- Add two general purpose lanes in each direction between I-295 and I-95

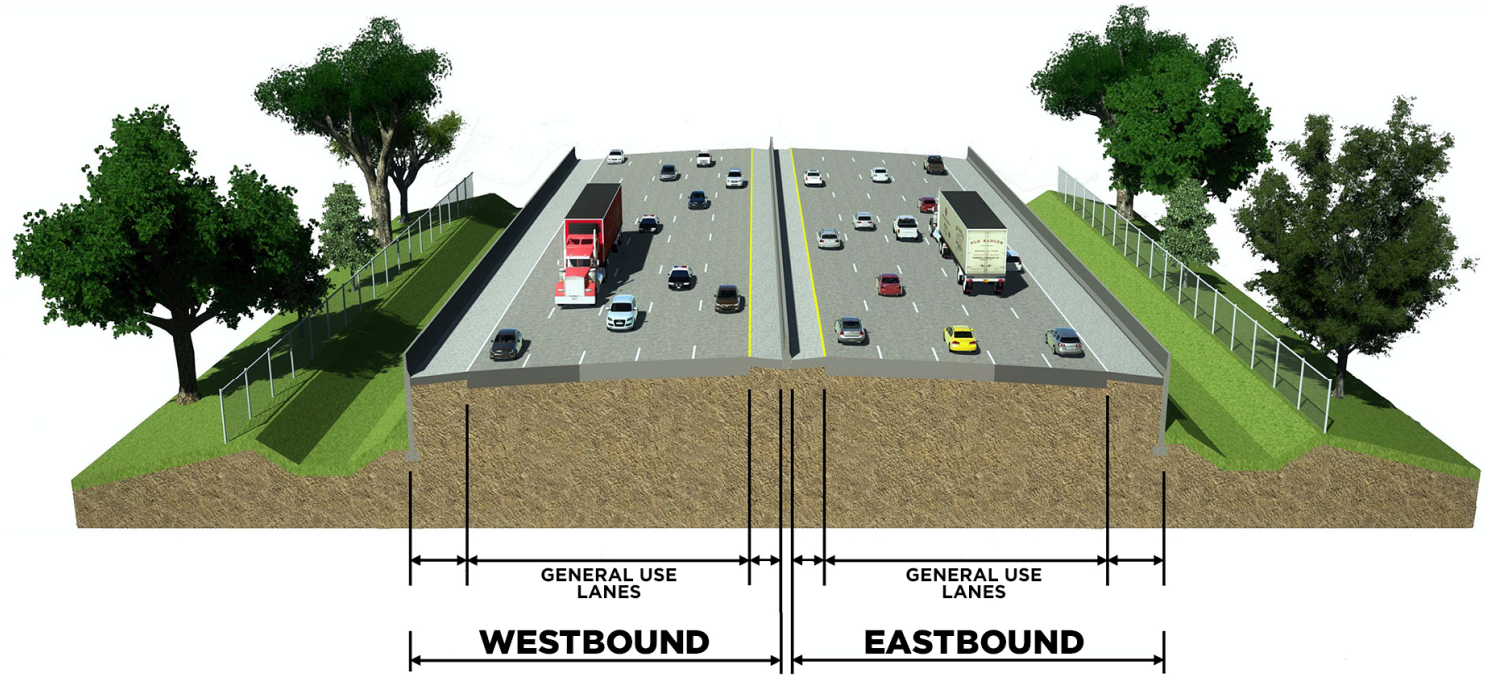
- Add two general purpose lanes westbound between Lane Avenue and Stevens Street

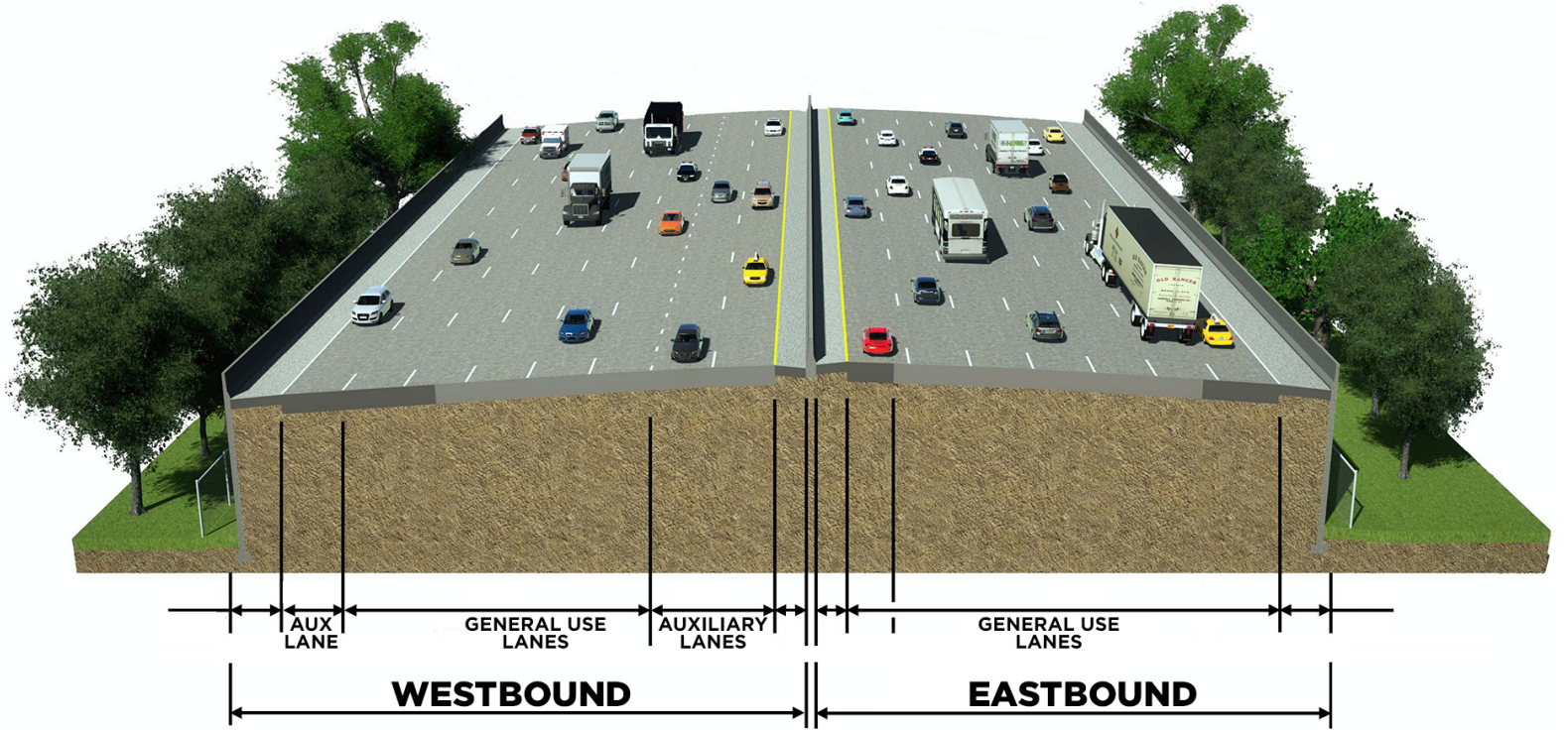
- Add two general purpose lanes in each direction between Stevens Street and U.S. 17

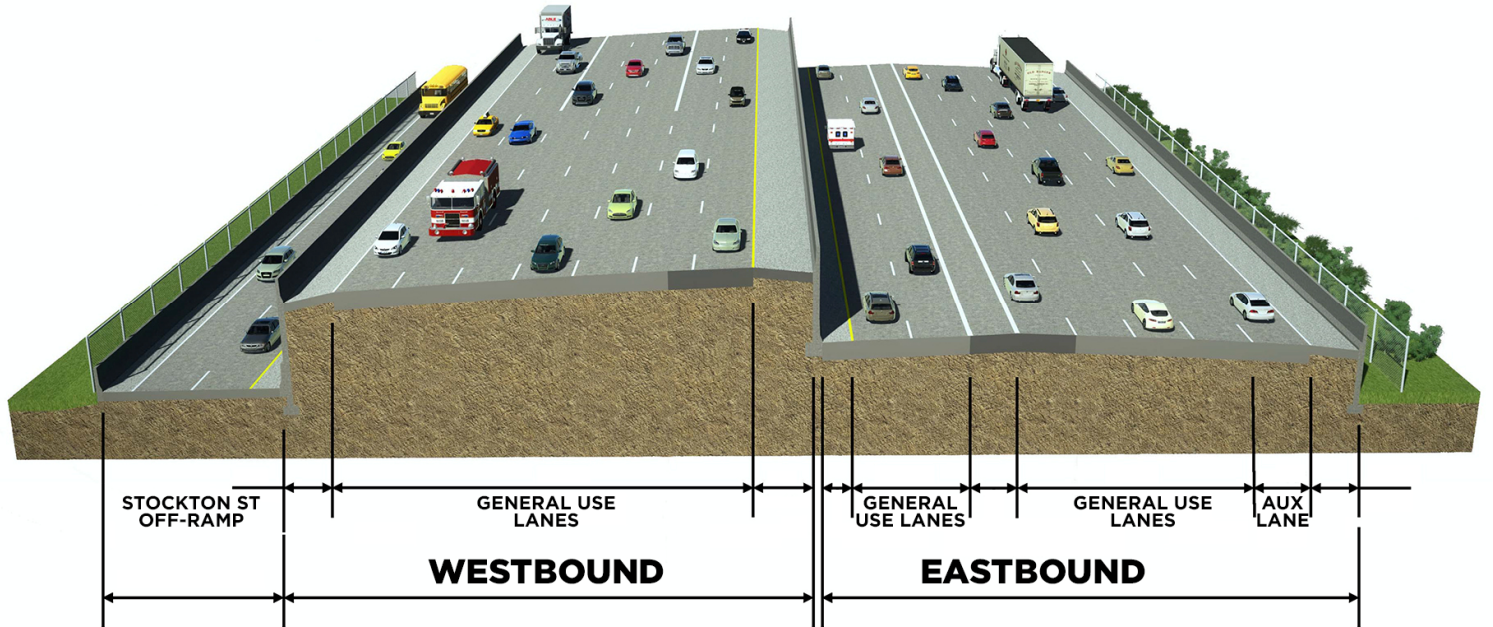
- Add two general purpose lanes in each direction between U.S. 17 and Stockton Street

I-10 from Stockton Street to I-95

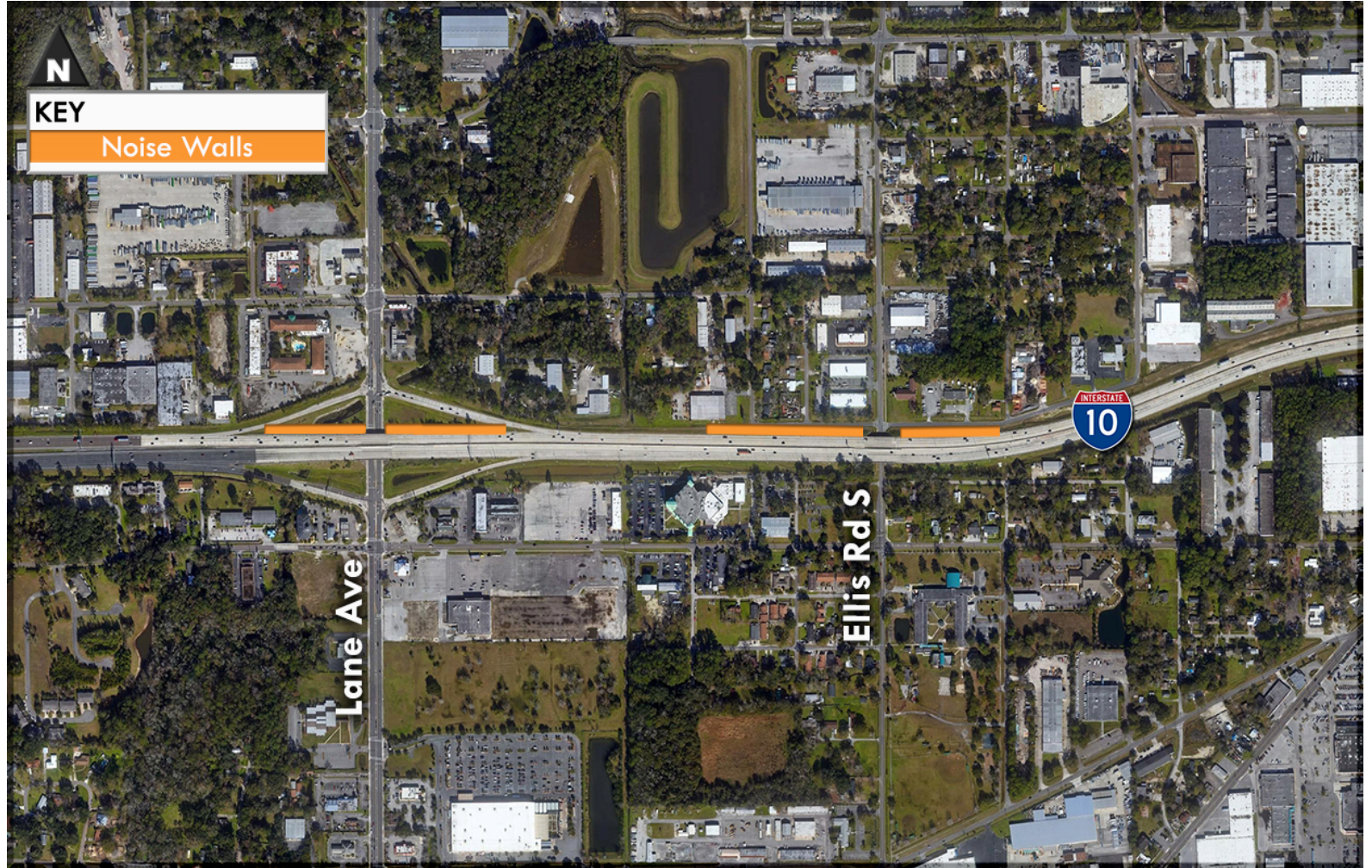
Project Improvements

- Create dedicated lanes from I-95 north and I-95 south to Roosevelt Boulevard



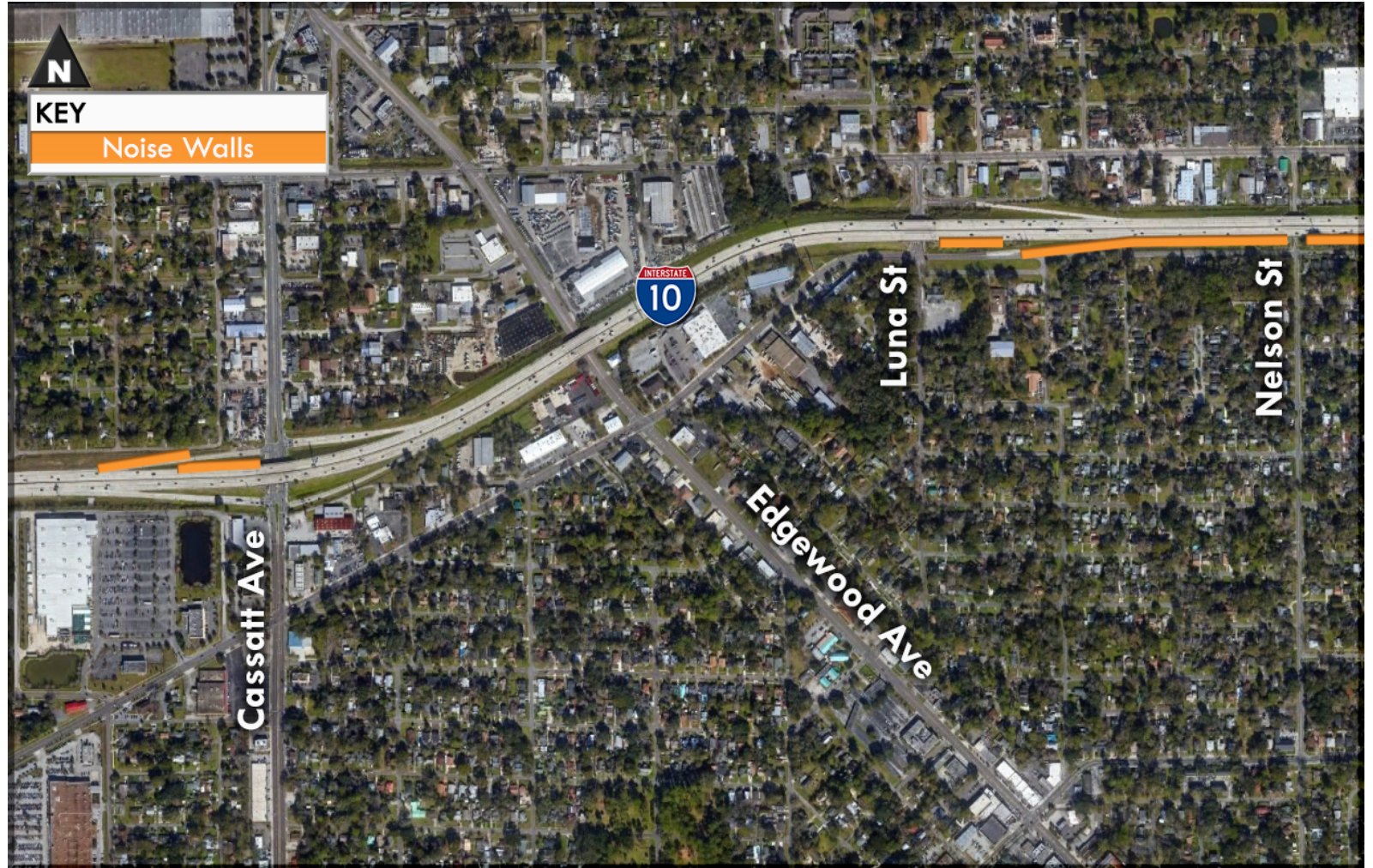

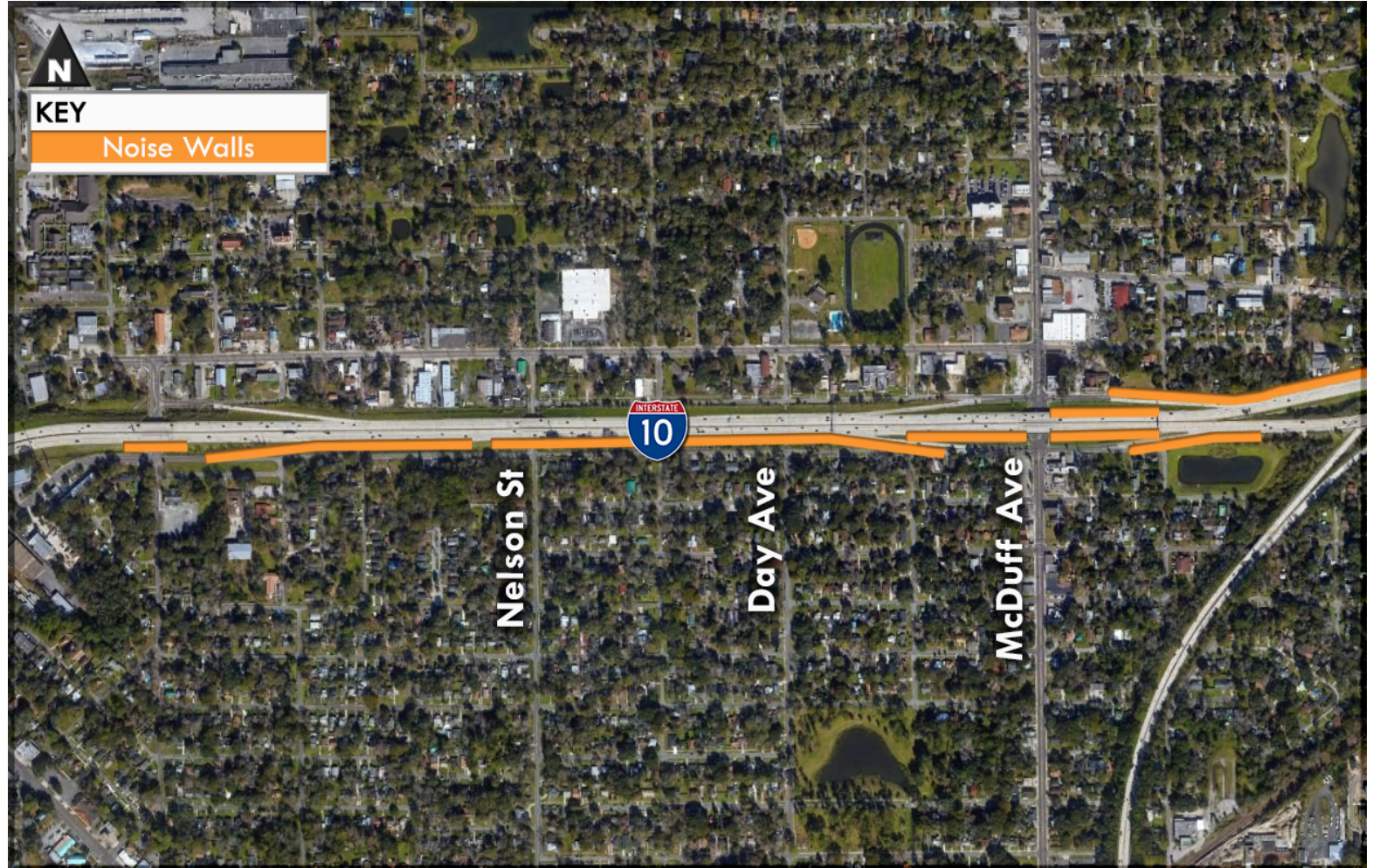

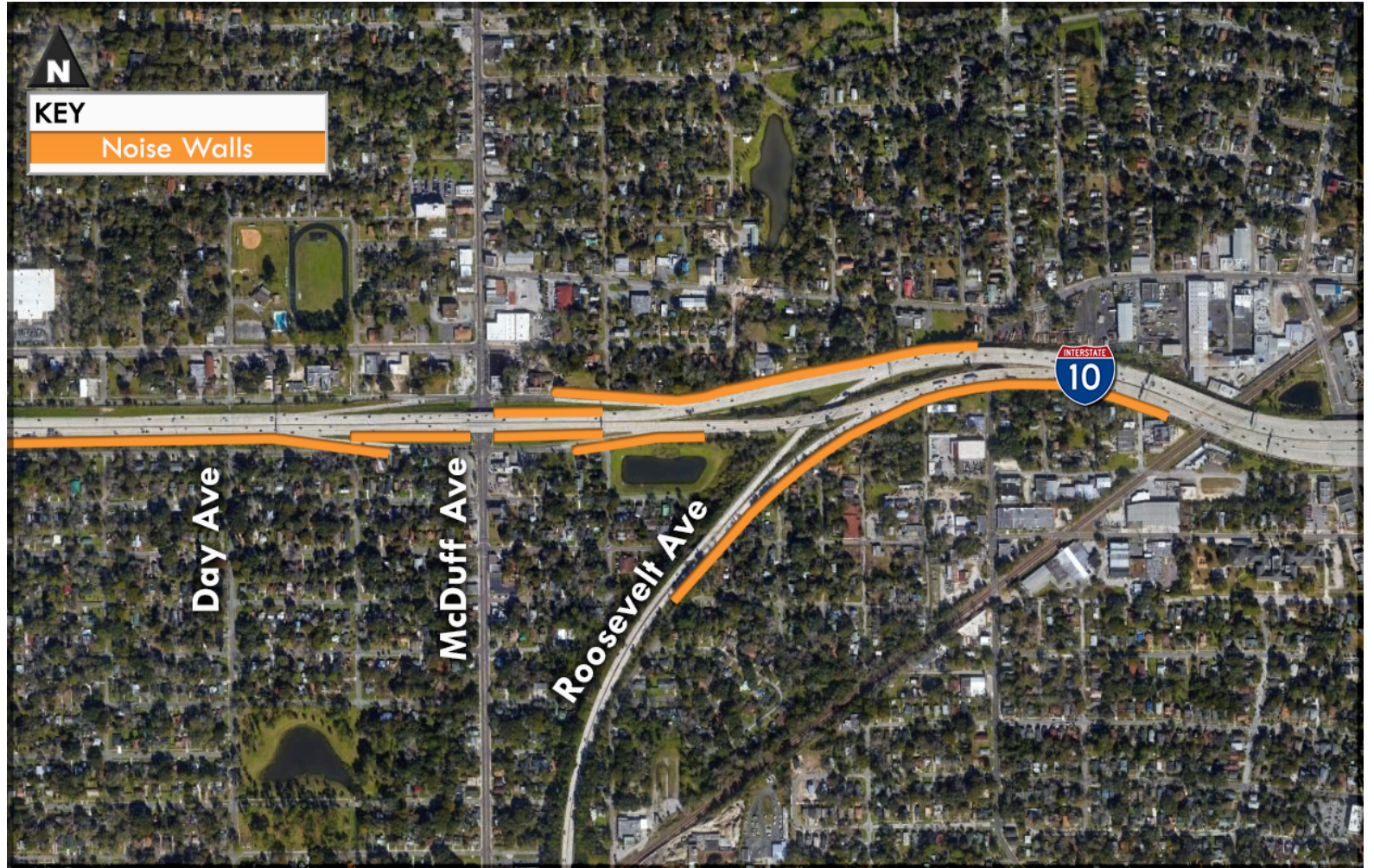
