


 Add two general purpose lanes in each direction between I-295 and I-95



I-10 from I-295 to Lane Avenue




 Add two general purpose lanes westbound between Lane Avenue and Stevens Street



I-10 from Lane Avenue to Stevens Street




 Add two general purpose lanes in each direction between Stevens Street and U.S. 17



I-10 from Stevens Street to US 17




 Add two general purpose lanes in each direction between U.S. 17 and Stockton Street

- Create dedicated lanes from I-95 north and I-95 south to Roosevelt Boulevard








 Construct noise barriers at prescribed locations throughout the project (slide 2 of 4)




