The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is considering a safety project to reduce collisions at the intersection of Beach Boulevard and Eunice Road. The safety project includes installation of a raised directionalized median at the intersection of Beach Boulevard and Eunice Road; extending the eastbound left-turn lane east of the Royal Palm Drive median opening; and closing the median opening at Royal Palm Drive. The objective of this safety project is to reduce angle and left-turn collisions at the Eunice Road intersection by restricting northbound and southbound vehicles on Eunice Road from traveling straight or making a left-turn. The project also includes new roadway signage and striping. (See Conceptual Improvement Diagram on the back of this page.)

To provide citizens with an opportunity to share input on the proposed changes, FDOT will host a hybrid public hearing **Thursday**, **December 3**, **2020**, online at nflroads.com/VPH or by phone at (562) 247-8422, access code 281-727-117. Citizens who are unable to participate virtually or by phone may attend the hearing in person at the FDOT Urban Office Training Center, 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. An informal open house will be held from 4 to 6 p.m., during which attendees may ask questions and discuss the project with members of the project team. A formal public comment period will begin at 6 p.m.

All in-person activities will follow sanitation guidelines; citizens are encouraged to use the virtual options for participation. Both virtual and in-person participants will be given equal opportunity to ask questions and make oral statements that will become part of the public hearing record. Persons who wish to submit written statements or other exhibits may do so prior to or during the hearing in the comments section at nflroads.com/VPH. Citizens may also submit questions, statements and other exhibits by sending them to Nick Hope P.E., Project Manager, via email at Nick.Hope@dot.state.fl.us or traditional mail at 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before December 13, 2020 will become part of the public hearing record. Project-related documents are currently available for review at nflroads.com/VPH.
