The purpose of this public hearing is to give interested persons an opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, and social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements.

PROJECT HISTORY

A Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study is underway to evaluate alternatives to improve safety, capacity, and traffic operations on I-95 from I-10 to Beaver Street. The proposed project will rehabilitate and replace the deck of the Myrtle Avenue Bridge (Bridge No. 720163) as well as add up to two 12-foot travel lanes in each direction on I-95. Access changes along side streets are also proposed.

In August 2022, FDOT held a virtual and in-person Public Kickoff meeting for the I-95 Improvements from I-10 to Beaver Street PD&E study. At these meetings, residents and interested stakeholders were able to review the project and provide comments regarding the improvements. Since that time, changes have been made to the proposed project and these changes are included in this brochure.

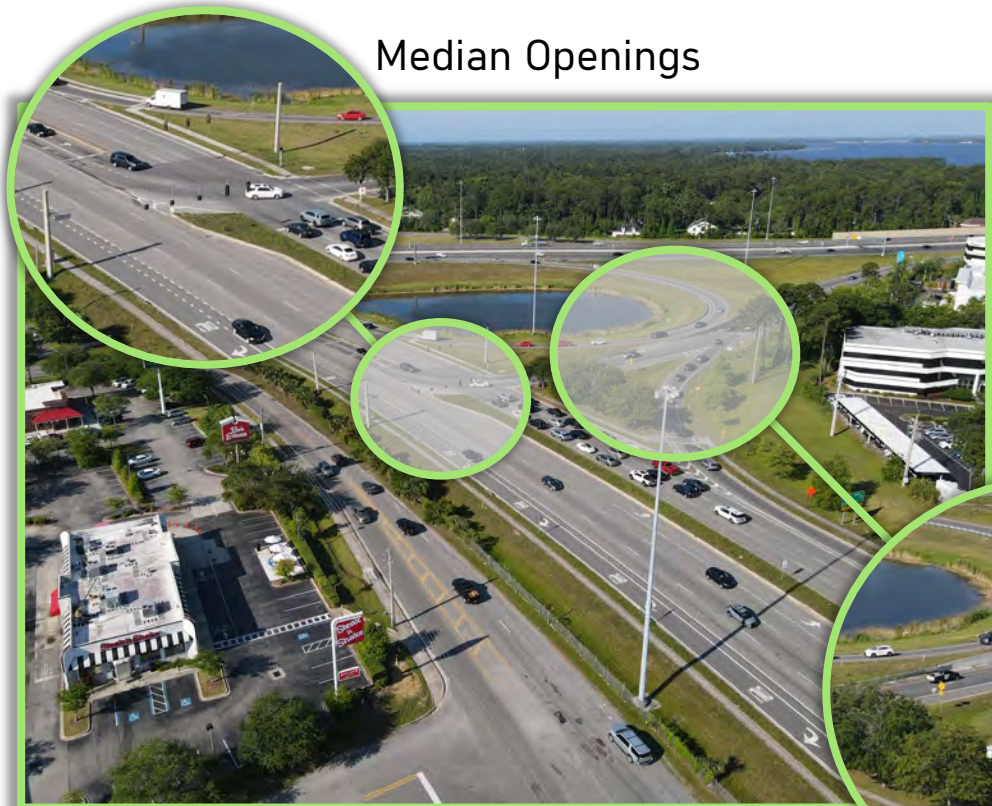

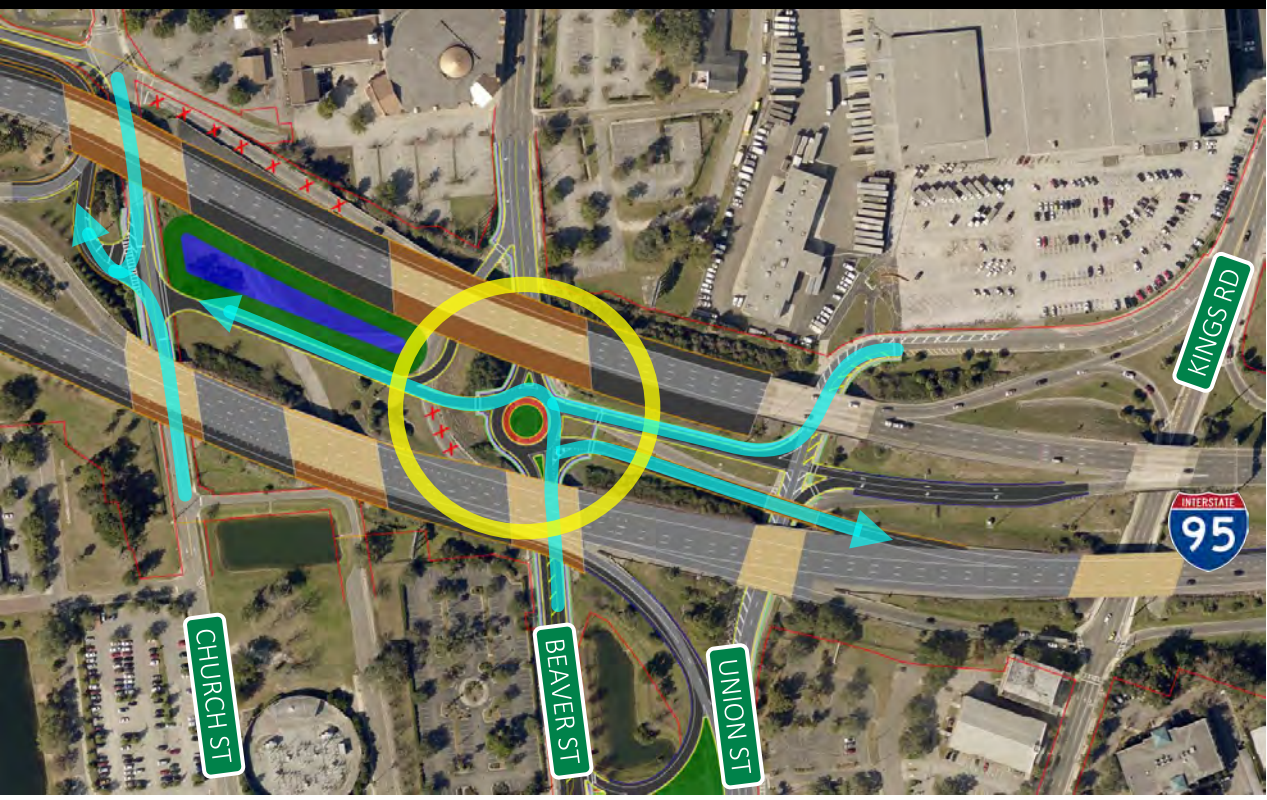




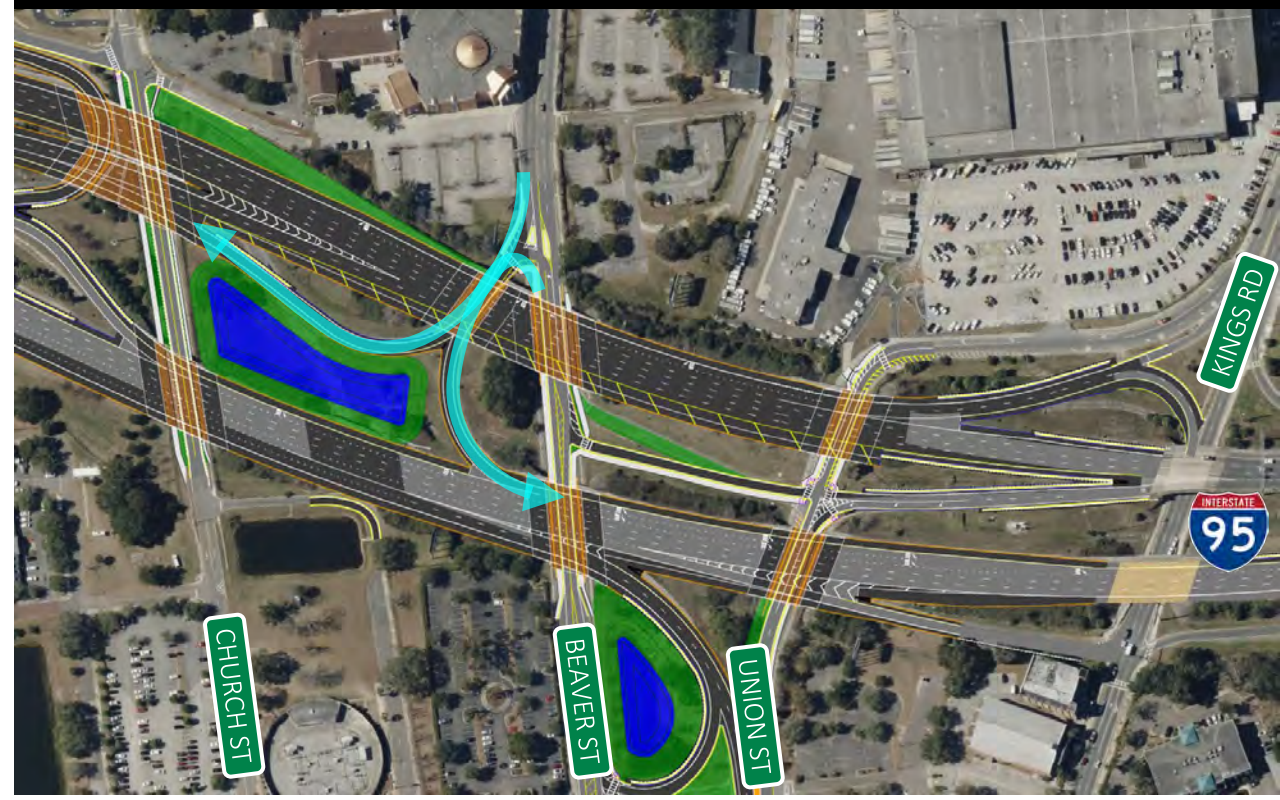
Proposed Access Change I-95 Ramps and Beaver Street Intersection

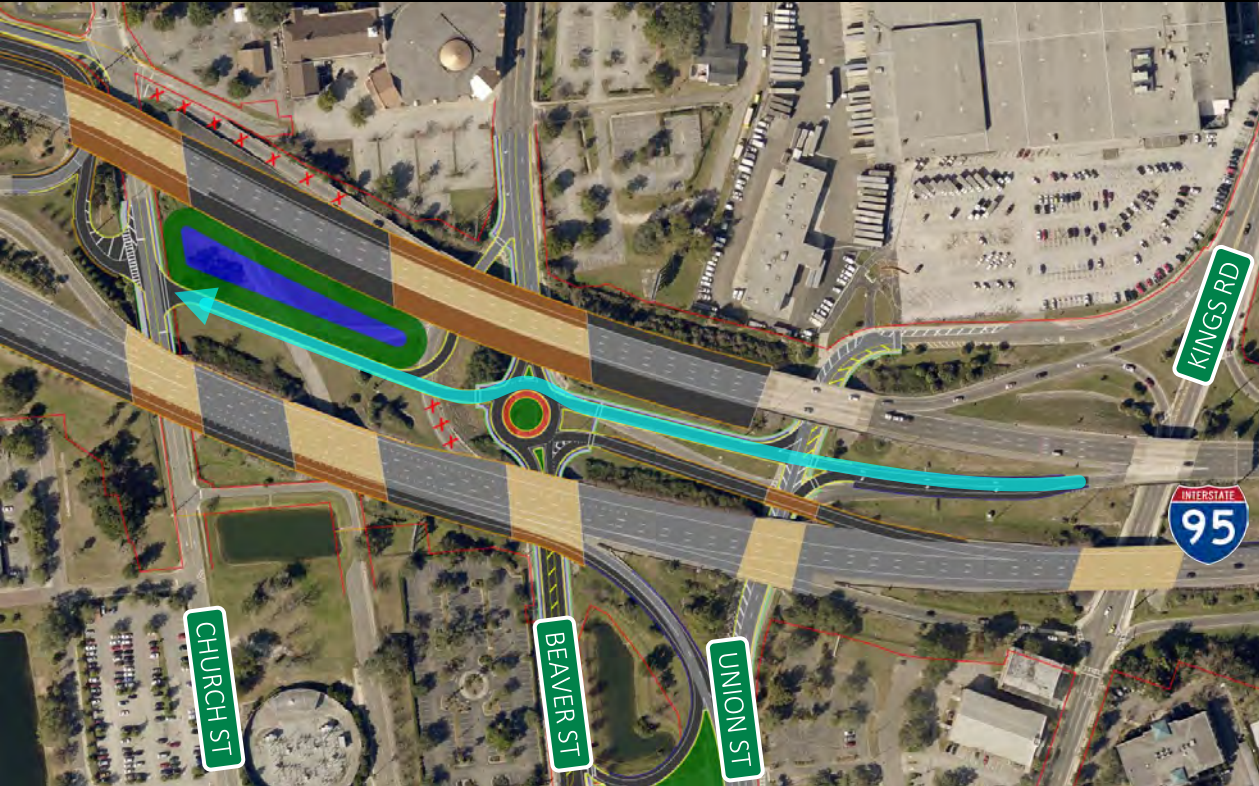




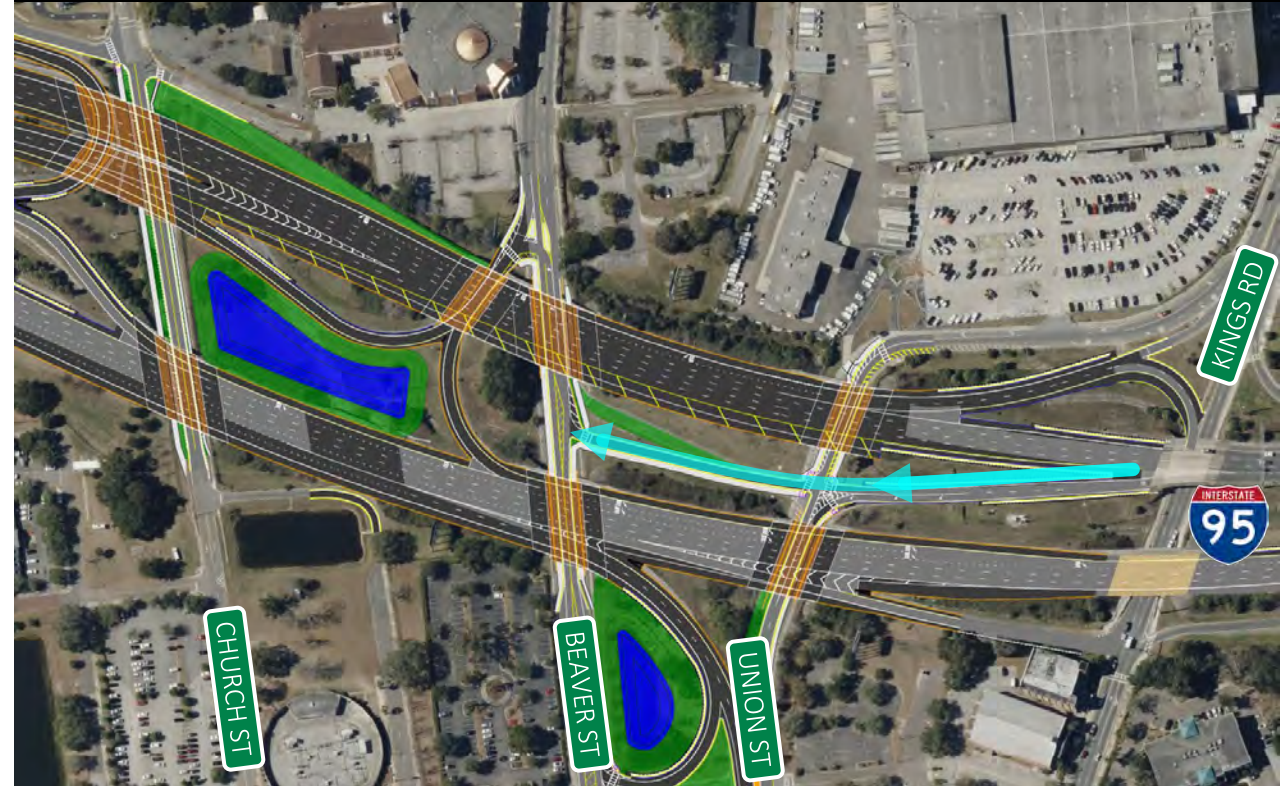
Proposed Access Change I-95 Southbound Exit to Church St.

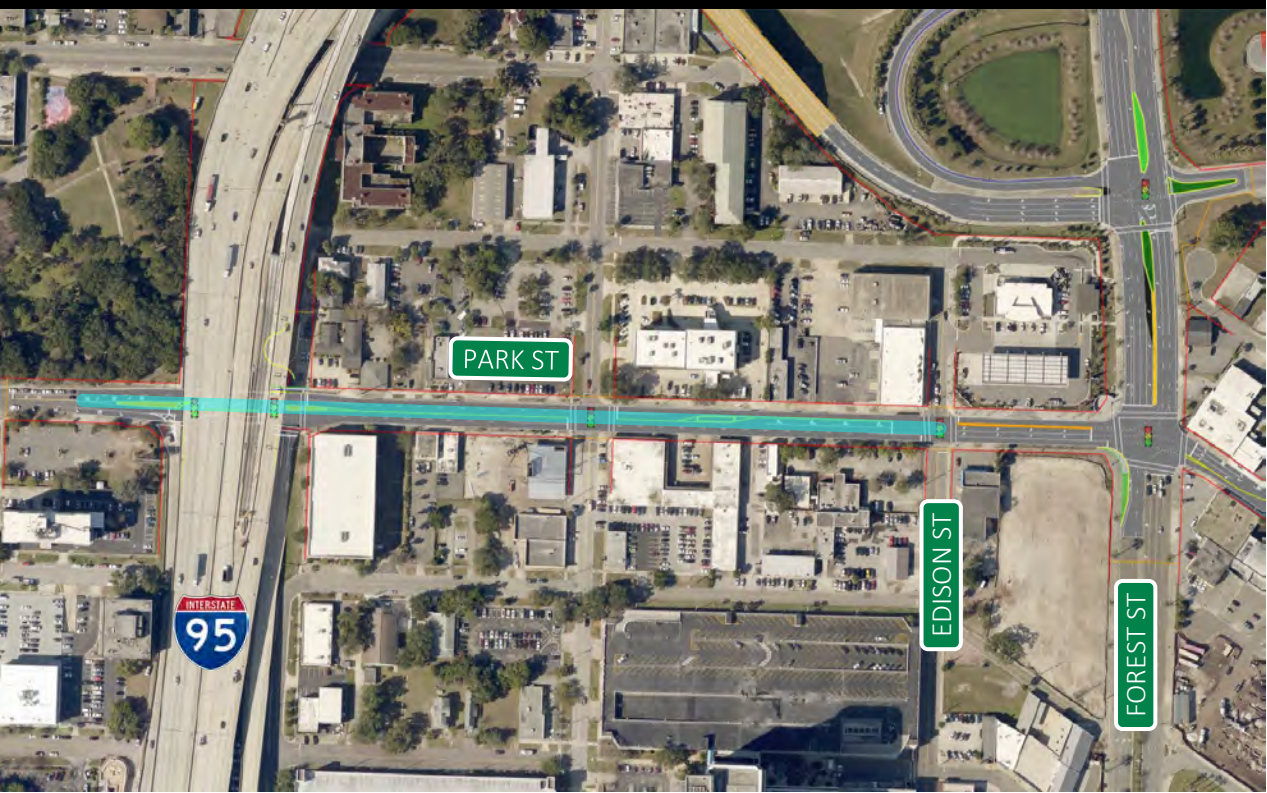

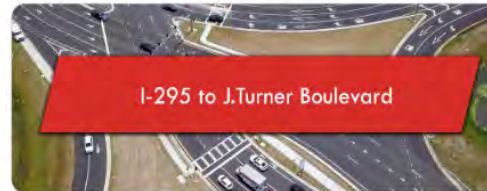
Learn more about the changes that are coming to I-95

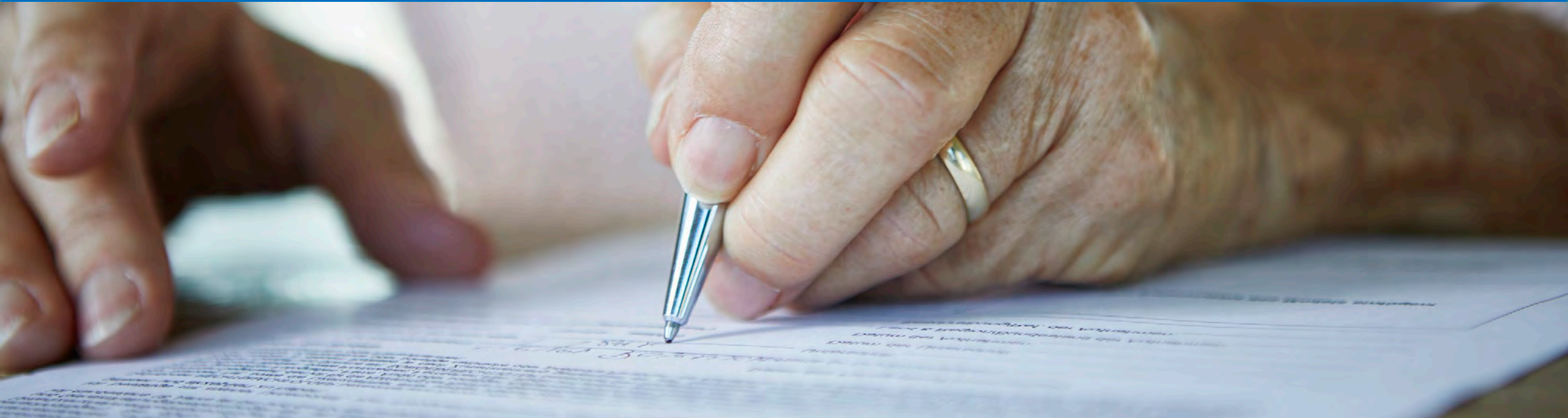

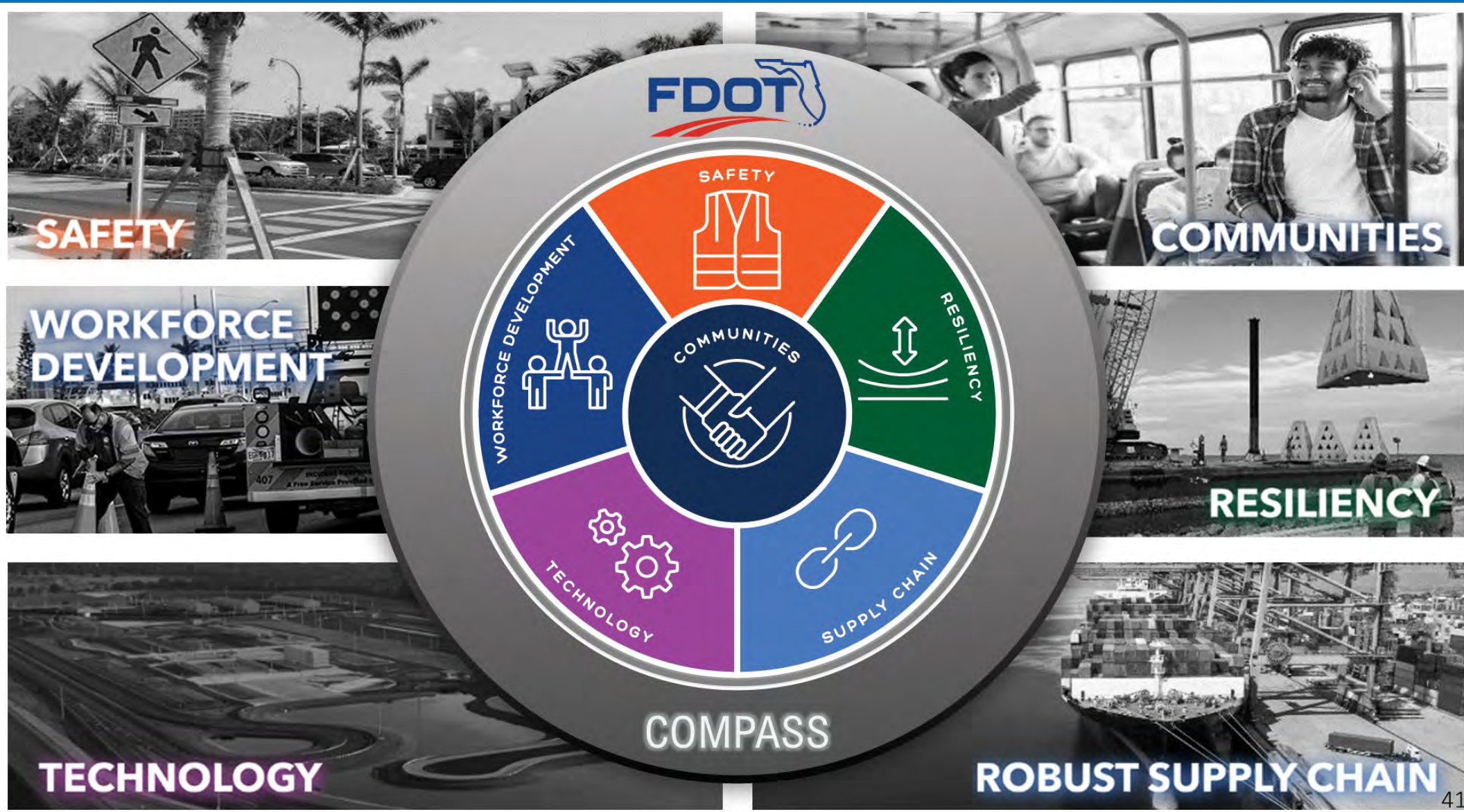
