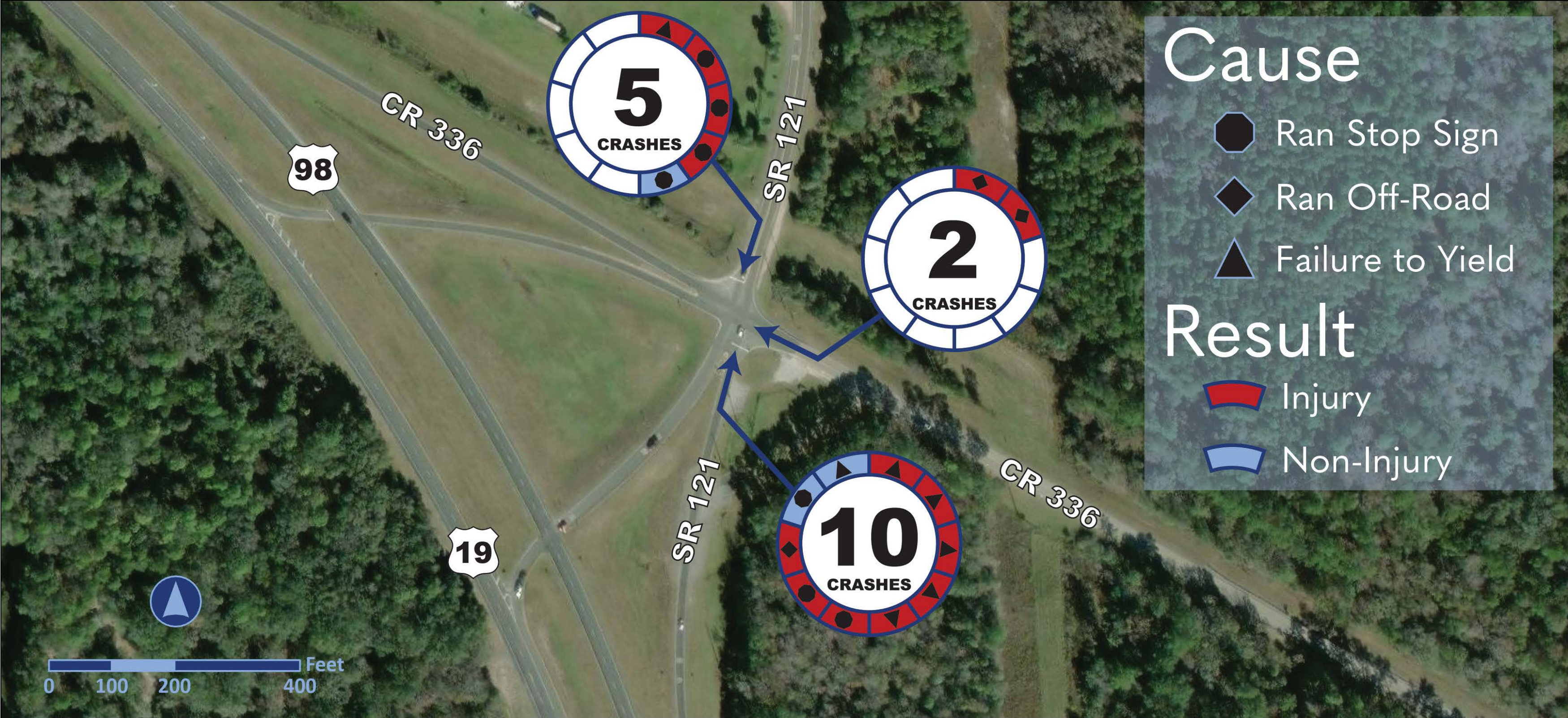

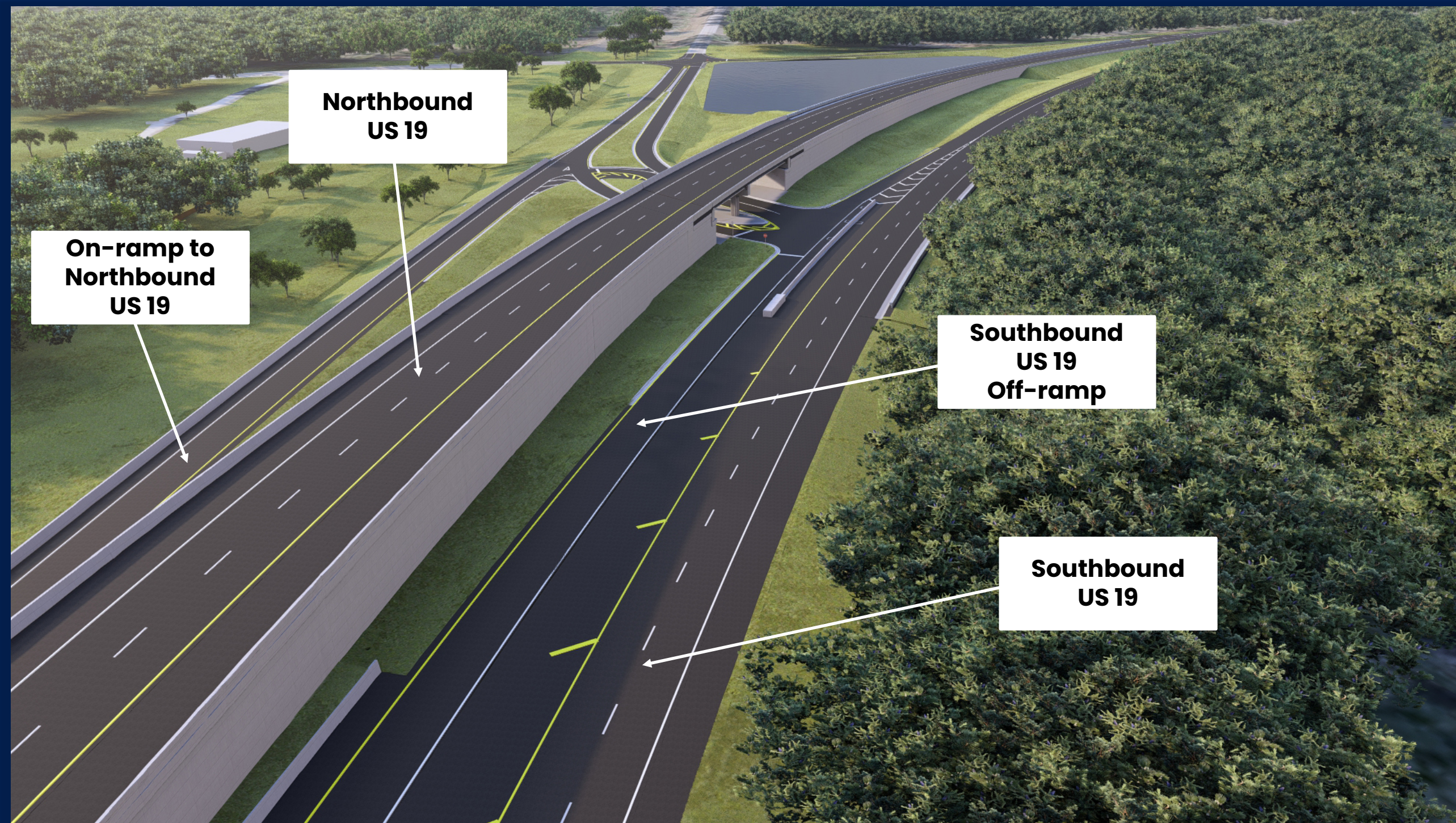


# Purpose

The purpose of this project is to improve safety by reconfiguring the intersection while providing free-flow traffic conditions on US 19.

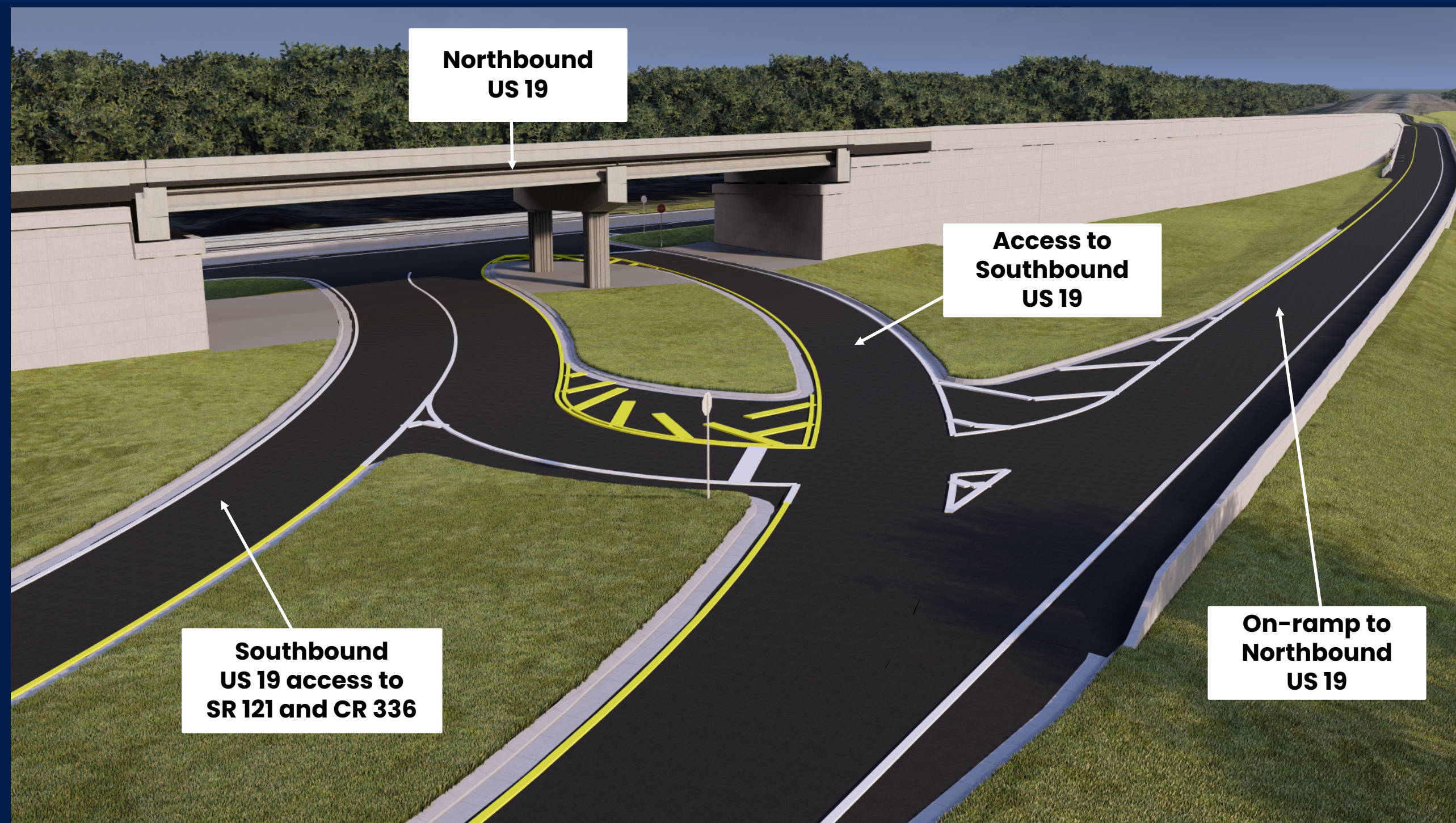

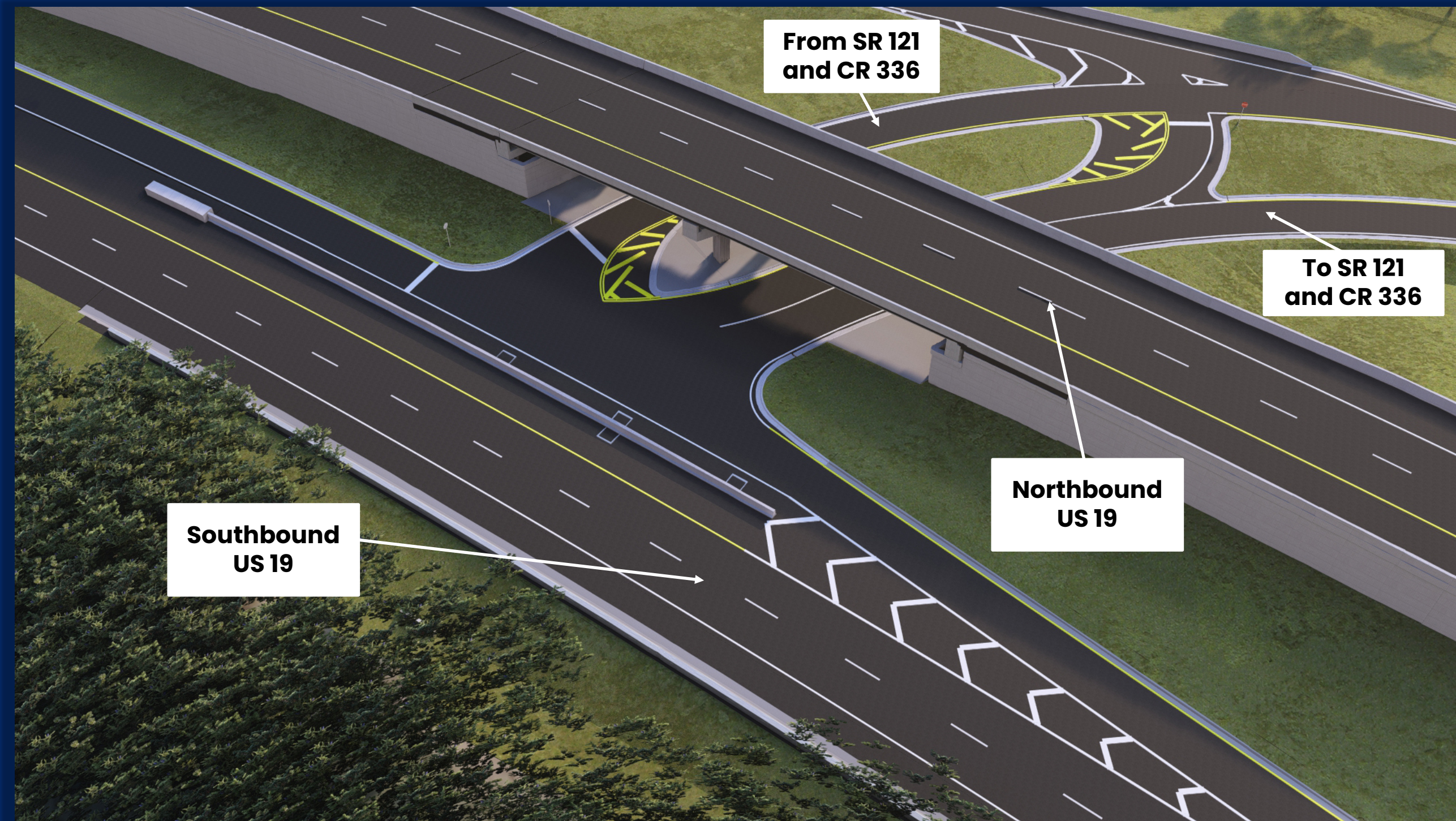

- Florida Department of Environmental Protection State 404 General Permit

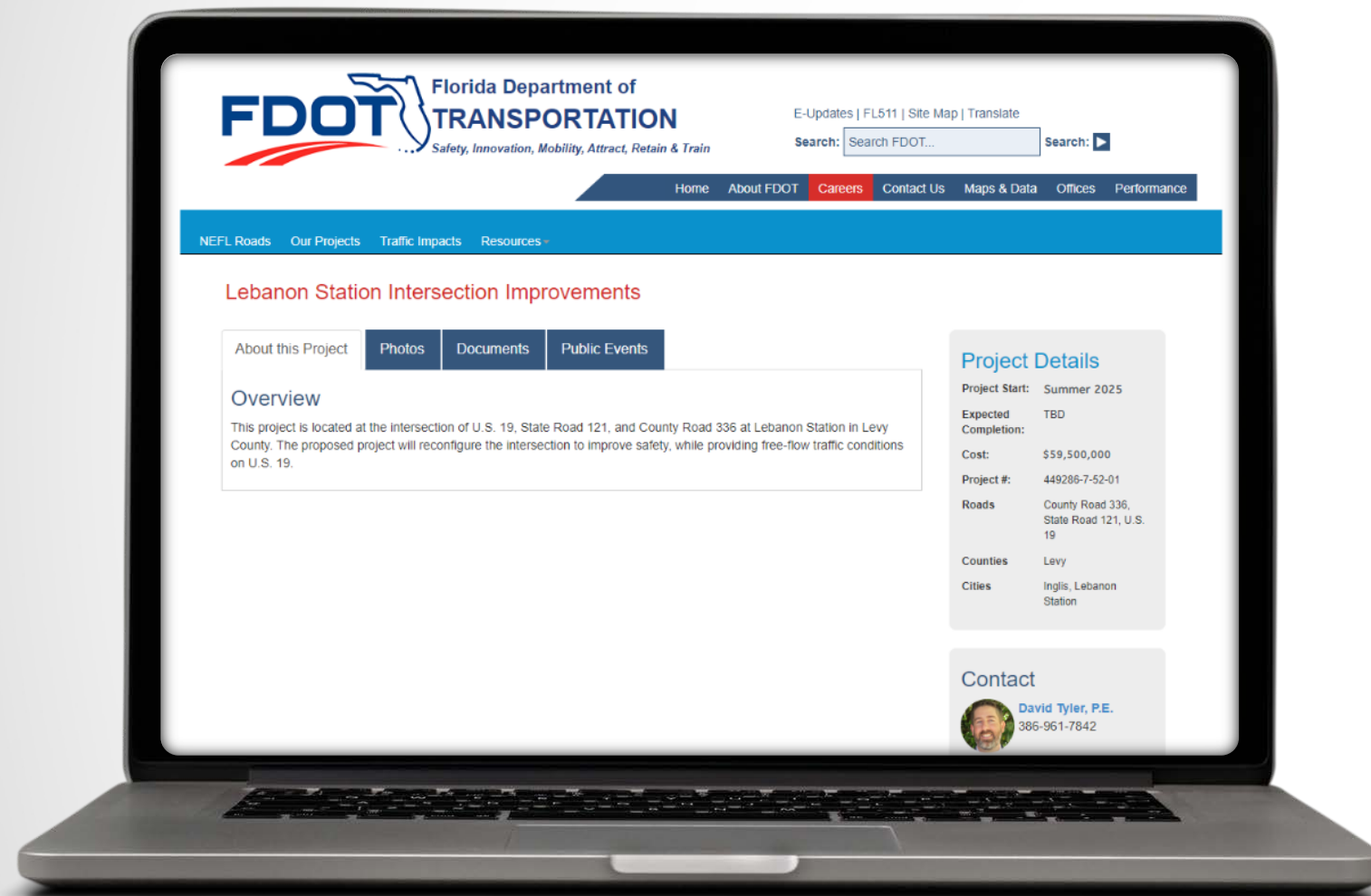

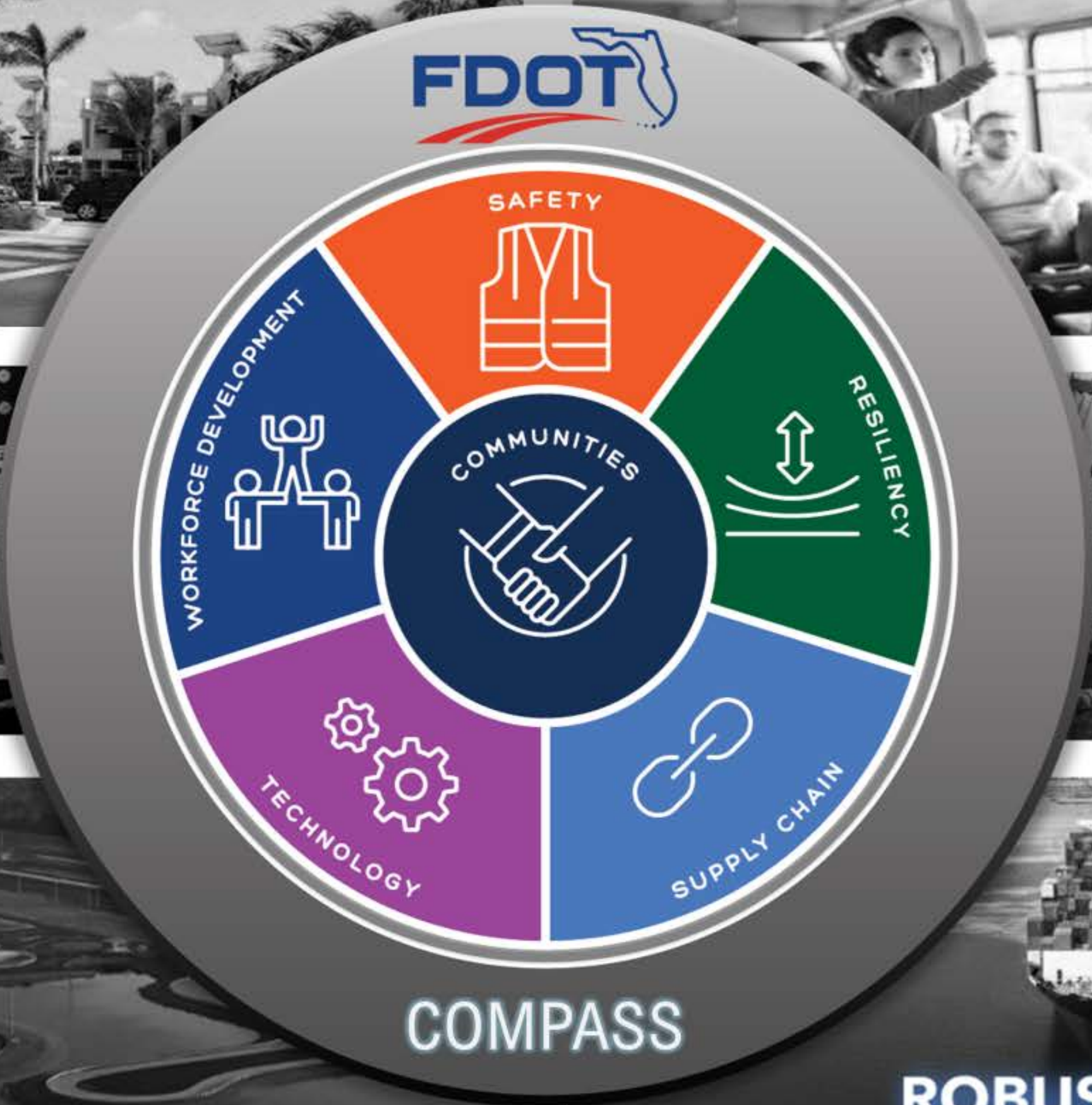
