
What is Lane Repurposing?


- Sometimes referred to as road diet, lane reduction, or lane elimination
- Reassign roadway space to other purposes, such as:
 - Enhancing safety
 - Encouraging economic development
 - Improving mobility for all users
- Traffic analysis is conducted to ensure that repurposing a travel lanes to other purposes will NOT cause traffic congestion or backups
















