

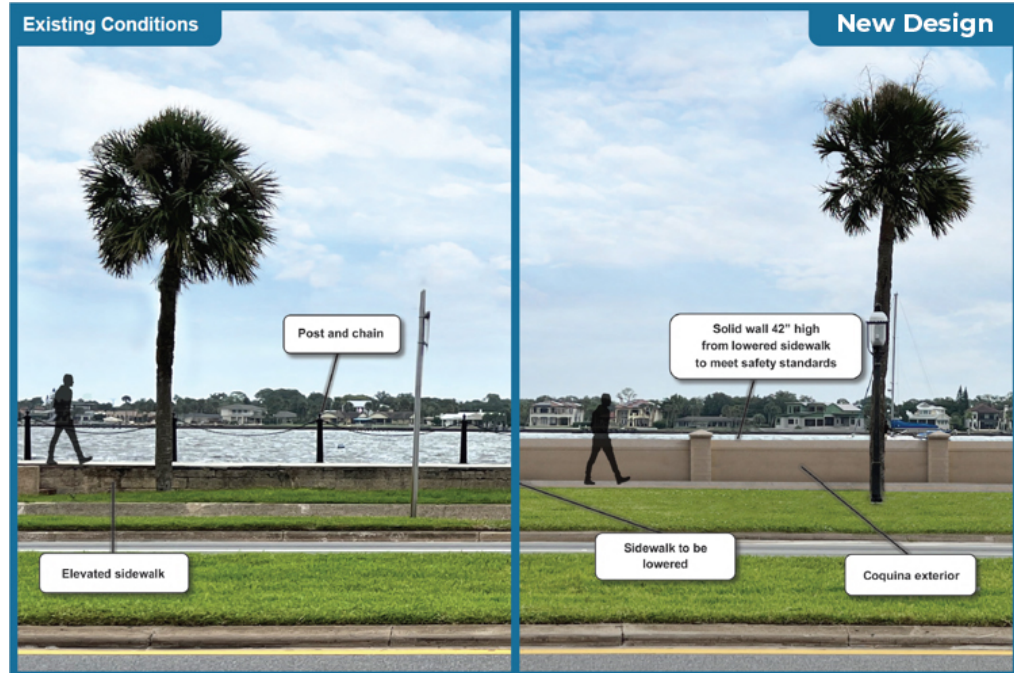

ABOUT THE PROJECT

State Road A1A from Bridge of Lions to Charlotte Street Seawall Replacement

St. Johns County, Florida



Construction starts: June 2026
Construction ends: Fall 2027

Contractor: Vecellio and Grogan, Inc.
Cost: \$19.9 million

The Florida Department of Transportation is scheduled to replace the seawall along State Road A1A from the Bridge of Lions to Charlotte Street in historic downtown St. Augustine.

Crews will begin construction operations on **Monday, June 15**. Construction will take place through fall 2027, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Construction will take place mainly by barge, minimizing impacts to traffic. Pedestrian detours will be installed during construction.

This project focuses on enhancing pedestrian safety and accessibility, strengthening protection of State Road A1A from king tides, and preserving the aesthetics of the historic area. Improvements include replacing the seawall, reconstructing the promenade, replacing the post and chain barrier with a solid 3.5-foot coquina concrete wall, removal and reconstruction of timber pergolas, removal of an event platform, and other incidental construction.

Vecellio and Grogan, Inc. was selected to complete this \$19.9 million project.

Traffic is being maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project. For more information about lane closures, visit www.nflroads.com.
