








## EXISTING TYPICAL SECTION

Access Management is the careful planning of the location, design, and type of access to properties, businesses, and homes. This includes guidelines for median and driveway openings. Access management serves to promote safe and efficient movement of people and goods by reducing traffic conflicts.

If you have concerns about the proposed access changes (median modifications) that may affect your property or business, you may appeal to the Access Management Review Committee and request an opportunity to present your concerns.
