
Purpose and Need

The purpose of the project is to improve safety and traffic operations at the westbound I-10 and Stockton Street Interchange ramps.



Traffic Safety Statistics

Proposed Improvements

1 To address safety and traffic operations at the I-10 and Stockton Street interchange, this project proposes to relocate the existing westbound I-10 on and off ramps to the east to extend the distance for vehicles merging onto I-10 westbound and to improve the on and off ramps' geometry.




Proposed Improvements






Proposed Interchange Access Change
