This meeting will inform the public of the proposed improvements and serves as an official forum providing an opportunity for the public to express their opinions and concerns regarding the project.

About the Project

This Access Management Project is being conducted to improve intersection operations, improve safety and improve pedestrian facilities. FDOT is proposing to reconfigure the intersection of Park Street at Blanding Boulevard (SR 21) from a signalized intersection into a roundabout, with the addition of pedestrian facilities along Park Street.


