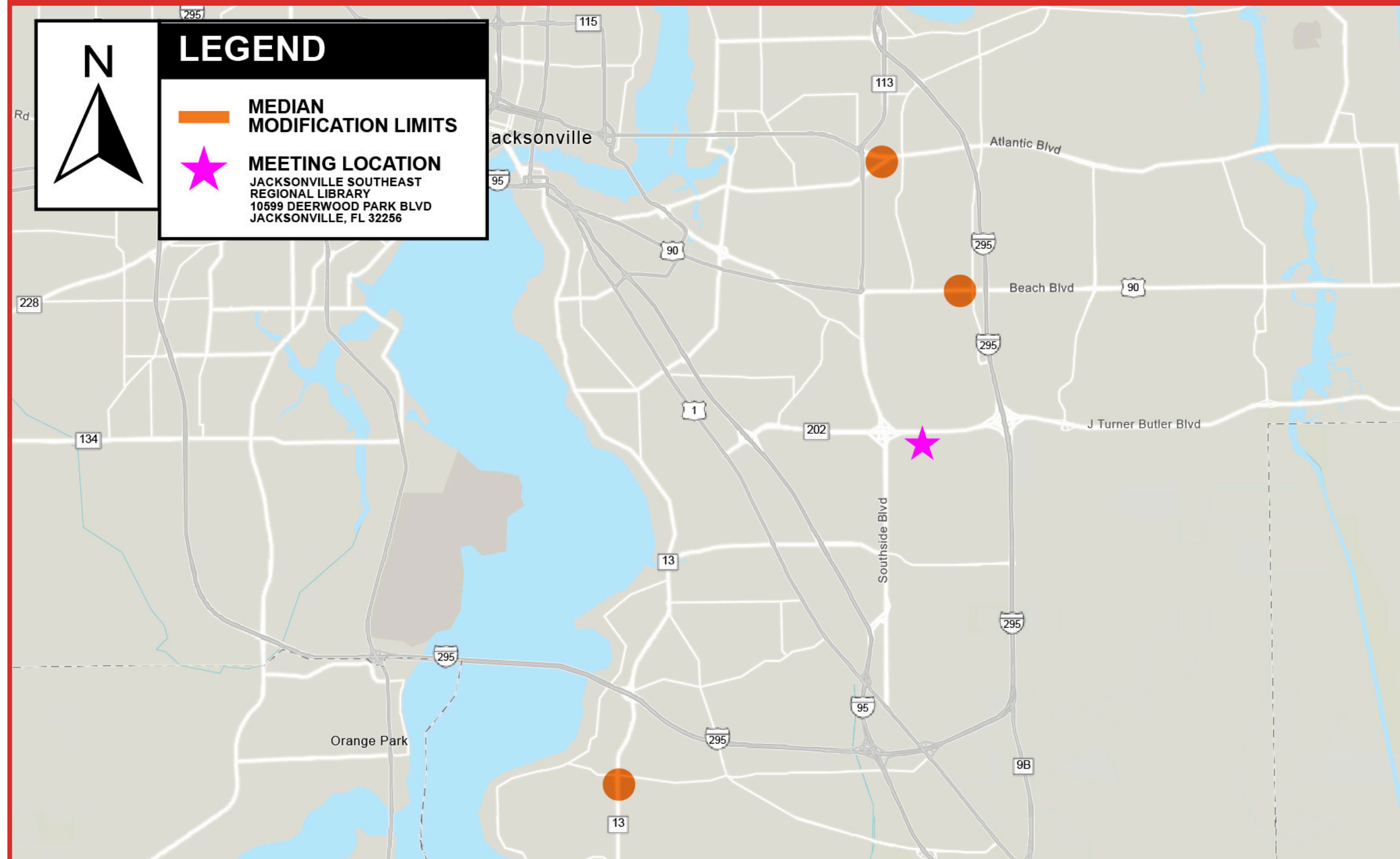

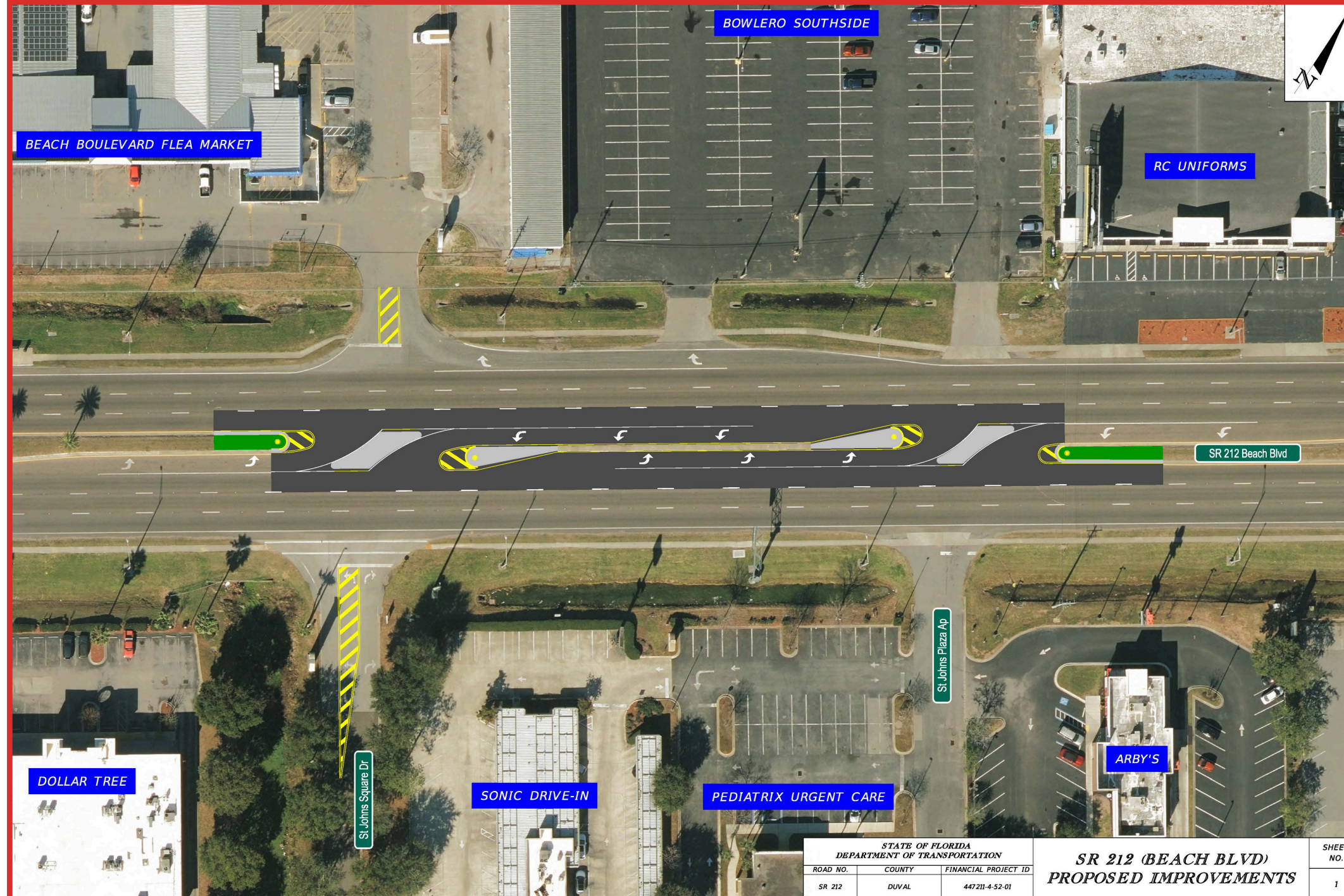

This project includes the following improvements on Atlantic Boulevard (State Road 10):
Construction of a directionalized median at Beacon Point Drive to eliminate northbound and southbound through and left-turn movements from Beacon Point Drive and the shopping center driveway to the north.

PROPOSED MEDIAN IMPROVEMENTS ON BEACH BOULEVARD (STATE ROAD 212)



This project includes the following improvements on Beach Boulevard (State Road 212):
 Construction of directionalized medians at St. Johns Square Drive and the St. Johns Plaza driveway to eliminate northbound and southbound through and left-turn movements from the shopping center driveways to the north and south.

PROPOSED MEDIAN IMPROVEMENTS ON SAN JOSE BOULEVARD (STATE ROAD 13)



This project includes the following improvements on San Jose Boulevard (State Road 13):
 Closure of the median south of Loretto Road to eliminate through and left-turn movements from the shopping center driveways, as well as left turns from San Jose Boulevard into the shopping center driveways.

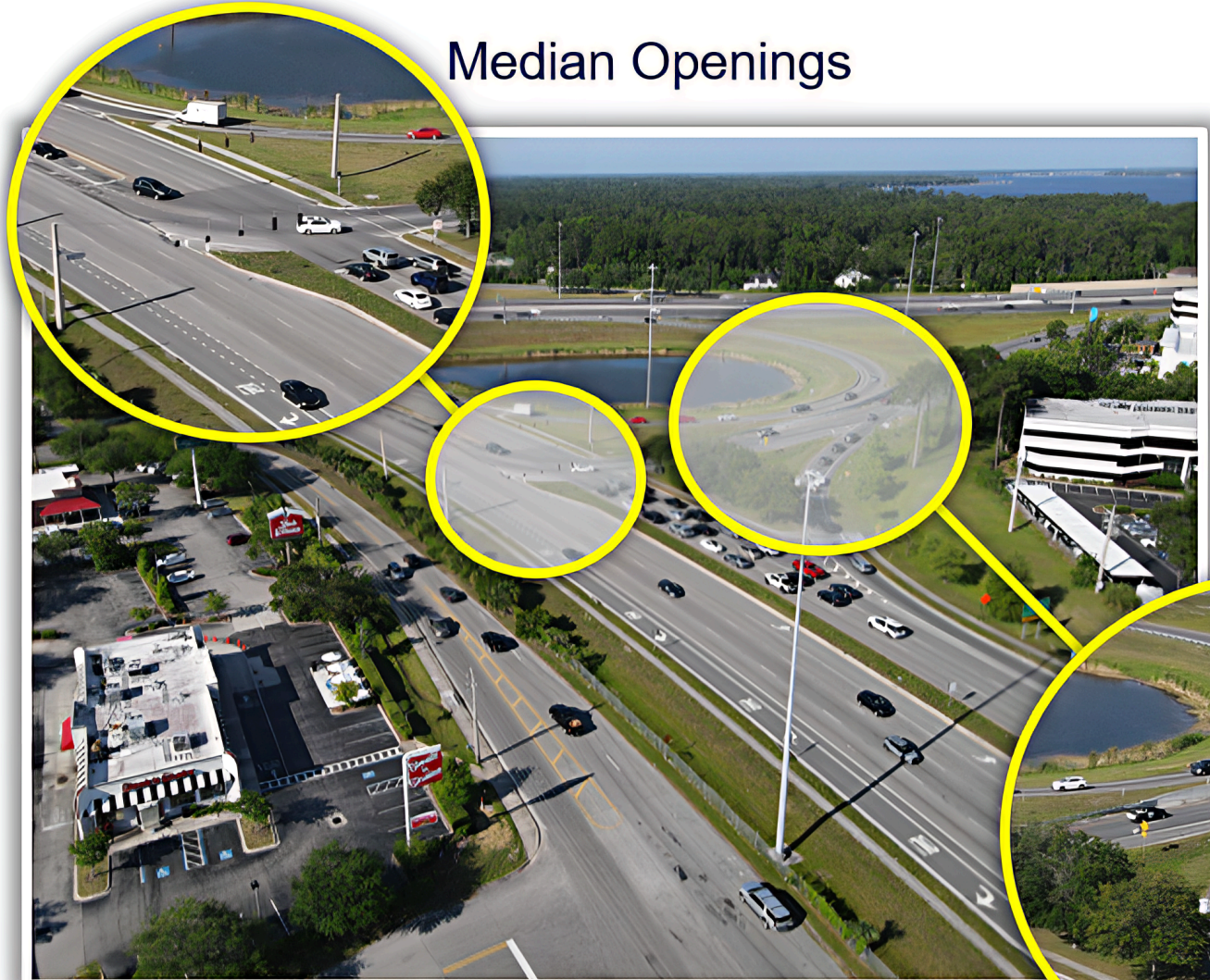

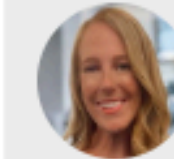
In-Person Public Meeting (Wednesday, July 1, 2026)

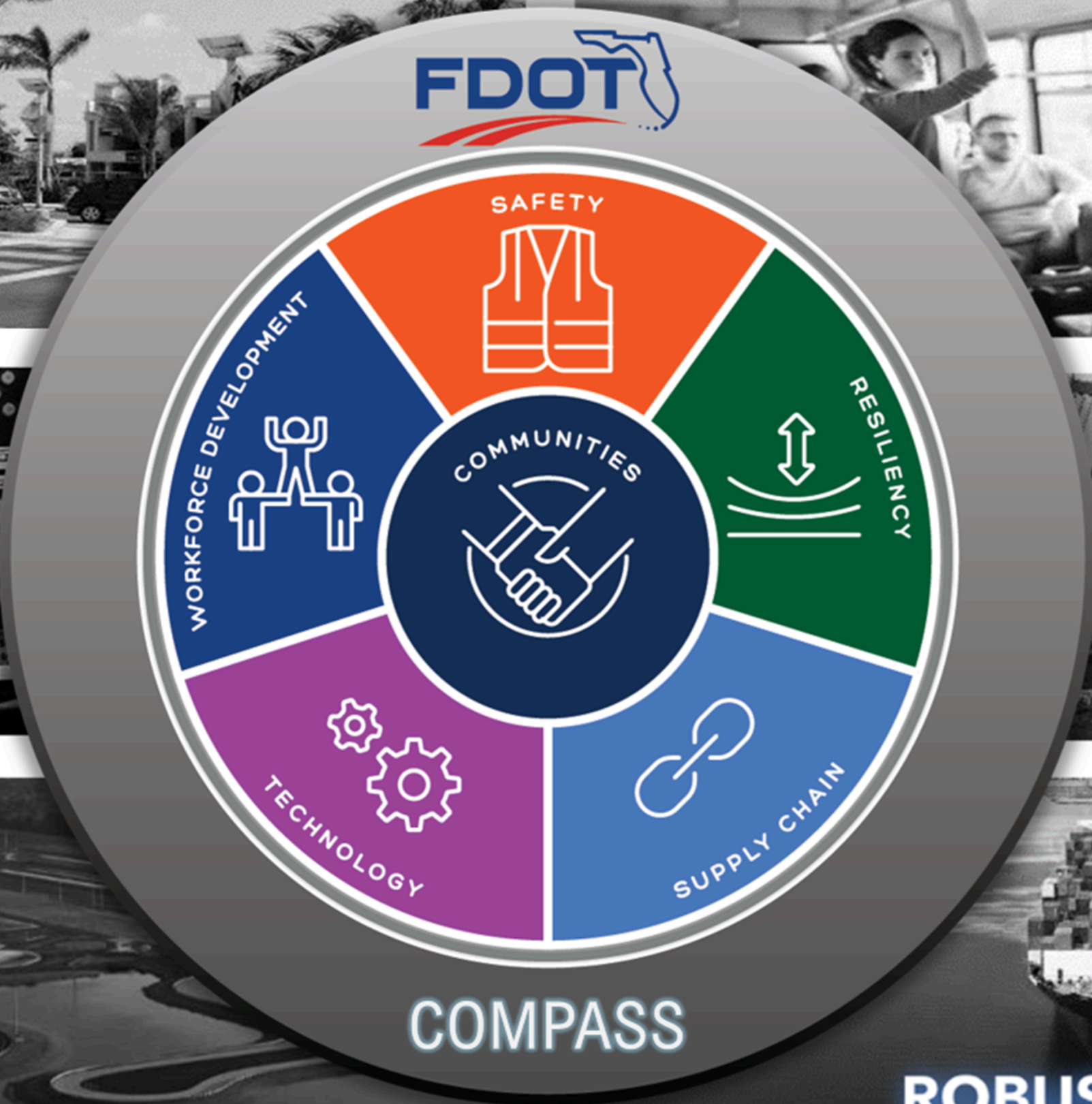
