



District Two of the Florida Department of Transportation invites you to attend a public meeting to discuss a proposed roundabout on State Road 45 (U.S. 41), south of Northwest 172<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, in Alachua County.

Bridlewood of High Springs, LLC has requested a permit to develop a subdivision for residential use. To maintain safety and manage access to the proposed site, FDOT would require the developer to construct a single-lane roundabout on State Road 45 (U.S. 41), south of Northwest 172<sup>nd</sup> Avenue. The developer would fund this construction at no cost to taxpayers.
