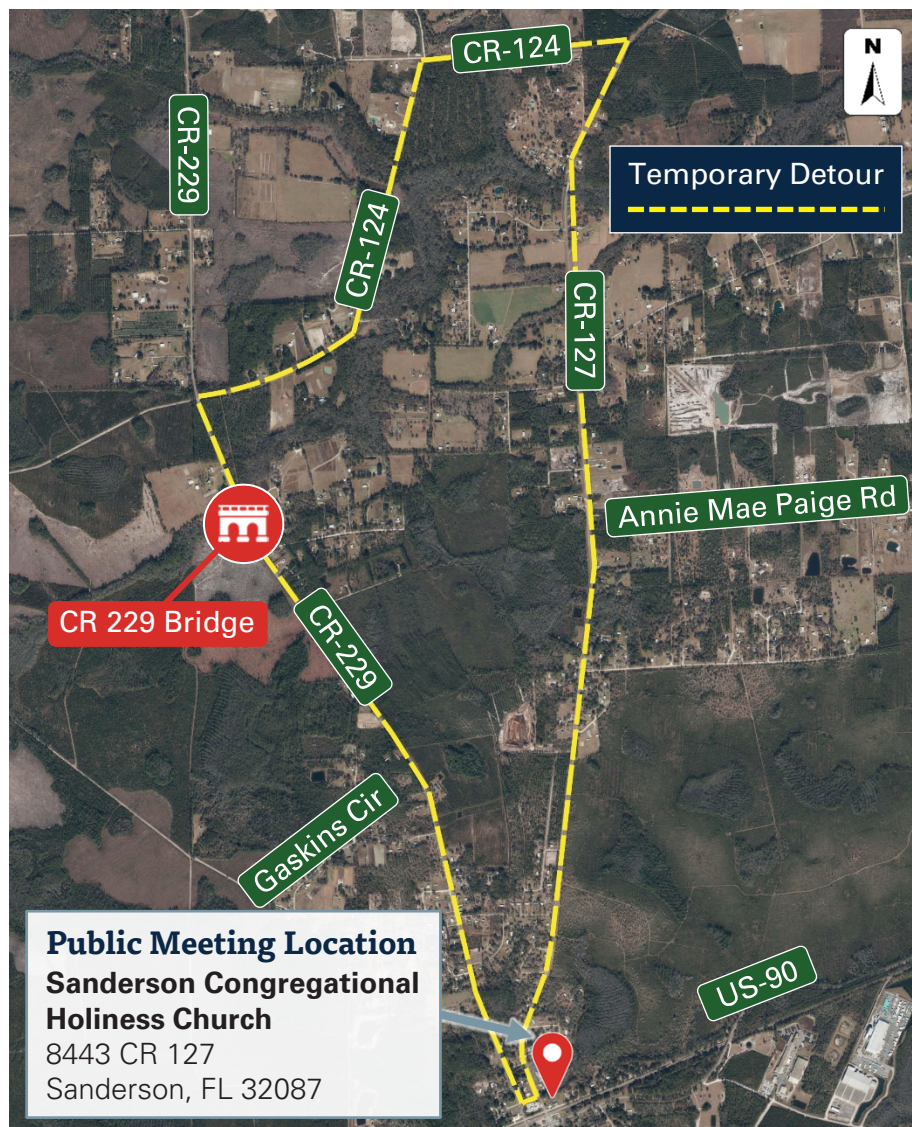

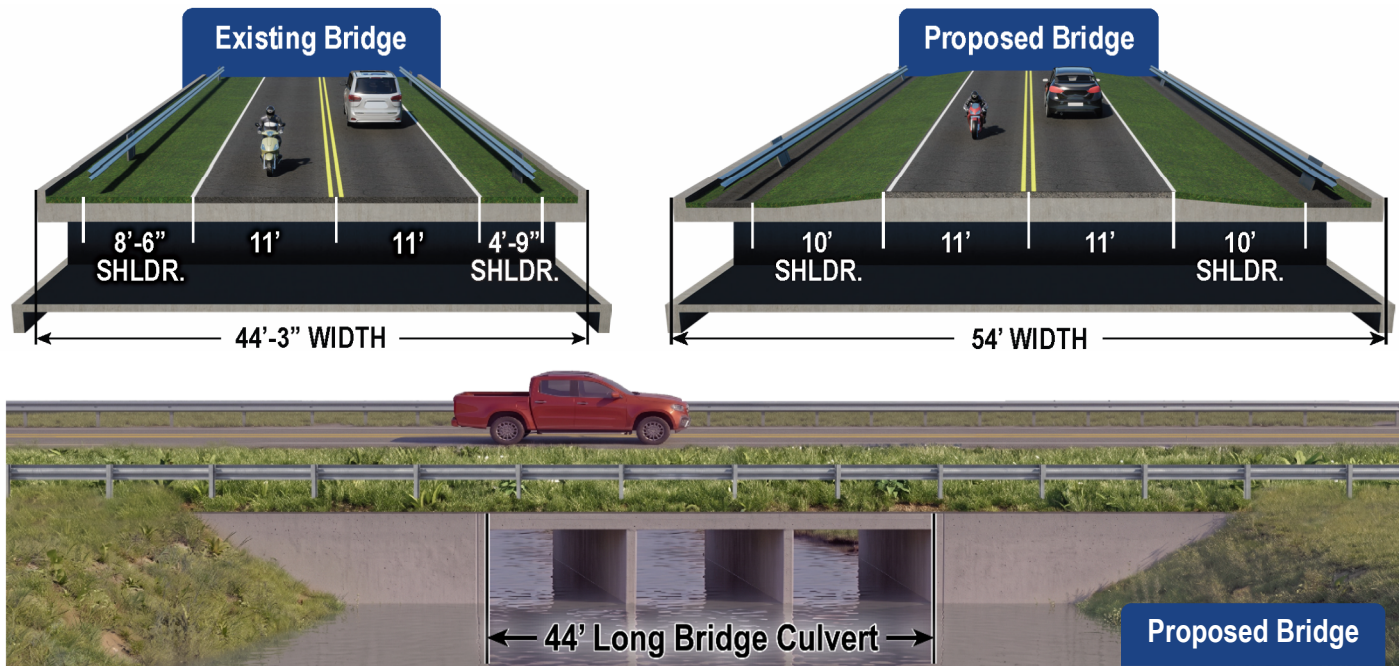

About the Project

The existing reinforced concrete box culvert at Cedar Creek, which was built in 1948, will be replaced with a 3-barrel reinforced concrete box culvert. CR 229 over Cedar Creek will increase from two 11-foot lanes with a 4'-9" shoulder on the east side and an 8'-6" shoulder on the west side to two 11-foot travel lanes with 10-foot shoulders. The roadway on either side of the culvert will consist of two 11-foot travel lanes and 8-foot unpaved shoulders.
